As a member of Cleckheaton Sports Club, you are expected to abide by the following principles:

- To respect the codes of conduct issued by their sport's governing body.
- To respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs, or sexual orientation or identity.
- To recognise the valuable contribution made by coaches and other officials who are usually volunteers: they give their time and resources to provide sporting and social facilities for members.
- To respect officials and publicly accept their decisions.
- To be a positive role model and treat sporting officials, club volunteers, other players and members as well as Club facilities with the same level of respect you would expect to be shown to you and your own property.
- To use appropriate language at all times, respecting the views of others who may be within earshot
- Not to smoke, vape or take drugs on Club premises or whilst representing the Club.
- To pay their subscriptions promptly and not later than eight weeks after the beginning of the season of their sport.
- Not to take part in any bullying or activities that are designed to humiliate another member or visitor to the club: bullying of any sort will not be tolerated: any bullying should be reported to a Club official.
- To encourage everyone to enjoy sport and understand that people have different motivations for taking part.
