1 Statutory information

Topsham RFC Bar Ltd is a private company, limited by shares, registered in England and Wales, registration number 09494070. The registered office is Bonfire Field, Exeter Road, Topsham, Exeter, EX3 0LY, England.

2 Compliance with accounting standards

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with the provisions of FRS 102 Section 1A Small Entities. There were no material departures from that standard.

3 Accounting policies

The principal accounting policies adopted in the preparation of the financial statements are set out below and have remained unchanged from the previous year, and also have been consistently applied within the same accounts.

Basis of preparation

The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention as modified by the revaluation of certain fixed assets.

Presentation currency

The accounts are presented in £ sterling

Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

Tangible assets are included at cost less depreciation and impairment. Depreciation has been provided at the following rates in order to write off the assets over their estimated useful lives:

Fixtures & fittings

10% reducing balance

Deferred taxation

Deferred tax arises as a result of including items of income and expenditure in taxation computations in periods different from those in which they are included in the company's accounts. Deferred tax is provided in full on timing differences which result in an obligation to pay more (or less) tax at a future date, at the average tax rates that are expected to apply when the timing differences reverse, based on current tax rates and laws.

Deferred tax assets and liabilities are not discounted.

Turnover

Turnover is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable, excluding discounts, rebates, value added tax and other sales taxes. Turnover from the sale of goods is recognised when goods have been delivered to customers such that risks and rewards of ownership have transferred to them. Turnover from the rendering of services is recognised by reference to the stage of completion of the contract. The stage of completion of a contract is measured by comparing the costs incurred for work performed to date to the total estimated contract costs.

Going concern

The Directors are aware that accounting standards set a high threshold for departing from the going concern basis. An entity is a going concern unless management either intend to liquidate the entity or cease trading, or that they have no realistic alternative but to do so. The Directors have no current intention to liquidate the Company or to cease trading. Rather, it is the Directors' intention for the Company to continue trading successfully into the foreseeable future. However, the current situation regarding the COVID-19 pandemic is such that the Company is prevented from trading by the UK Government as the UK responds to the pandemic. It is not known how long this will persist. The Directors consider that the Company has sufficient resources to continue to meet all necessary costs during a further period of inactivity for the next 6 to 12 months at least. It is hoped that should a period of forced closure be imposed on the Company for a period of time in excess of this window, external financial assistance will be made available by the UK Government. The Directors are hopeful such an extended period of forced closure will not be required. Accordingly, these financial statements are prepared on the basis that the Company is a going concern at the date on which these financial statements are signed.
