## Update Workshop

Coach Education courses have dramatically changed in the past 12 months. We no longer have level 1 and level 2 but instead the opportunity of certificates and diplomas.

The new courses are designed to be more player-centred than the previous coach assistant (UKCC1) and club coach (UKCC2) courses with the emphasis on training coaches to better meet the individual needs of their players.

In order to facilitate this, the new programme will offer coaches the chance to become a specialist within their chosen area of work. Instead of offering 'level one' and 'level two' qualifications the new system is split into a young people and adults course (for those working with people aged 13 and older) and a coaching children course (for those coaching players under 13). Both of these courses are equivalent to UKCC2 standard.

This workshop offers the opportunity for existing coaches to find out more about the new coaching pathway and the changes that have taken place. You will also be able to find out about future CPD opportunities that are expected to roll out in 2015.
