Housing & Boarding Information

Each room has two twin (single) beds, a night stand, desk, bathroom, and small kitchenette. All kitchen items (e.g., utensils, cooktop, crockpot, microwave) can be rented for the entire season for a nominal fee.

Internet is available on-site for \$10 per month. Laundry is also available on-site and is \$3.25 for wash and dry.

Food and Beverage employees receive one staff meal per shift.

All staff receive a 10-30% discount in restaurants and stores as well as golf privileges.

Students must arrive with \$723 for the \$688 refundable deposit, \$25 application fee and \$10 WiFi fee.

Transportation Information

Fly to Denver (land before 5:00 PM) and spend the night in a hostel (approx. \$60). The following day, travel by Greyhound Bus to Telluride. The bus ticket must be booked in advance and costs approx. \$75.

Salary Deductions

Federal Tax.....	10%

Taxes vary with income.

*If participants pay rent on time and attend scheduled work shifts, they will receive a \$144 stipend each month. This can be used for anything they want, however, if it is applied toward rent, rent will be reduced to \$200 per month. If stipend is not applied, rent will be \$344 per month.
