Description of Host Business

Through four generations, the Sonnenalp has grown into a world-class hotel, offering the finest in luxuries and comforts, as well as renowned personal service. Home to a spa facility, 18-hole golf course, exceptional dining, and shopping, it is steps away from the slopes of Vail and the heart of Vail Village. Working with the Leading Hotels of the World, the Sonnenalp ensures that it provides guests with only the highest quality service and standards.

Located in a mountainous area, winter and summer activities are popular: hiking, skiing, snowboarding, snowshoeing, rock climbing, biking, and skate-boarding. There are also world class restaurants, musical venues, events, and non-traditional sports like soccer-golf, frisbee-golf, and snow biking. There is a lively cultural scene with various festivals, farmers markets, and free concerts.

Staff receive \$1/minute spa services and food and beverage discounts. A free shuttle will take staff anywhere in Vail.

Housing & Boarding Information

One meal is provided per shift.

Housing is off-site at multiple locations, including East Vail, Vail Village, West Vail, and Eagle-Vail. The rent varies by location, from \$475-\$675/month for a shared bedroom to \$650-\$1,000/month for a single bedroom. Electricity, gas, hot water and trash are included in the rent. Some locations provide Internet (\$50/month). You are responsible for cable, Internet, and cleaning/laundry supplies. A \$500 security deposit is required to move in; of this, \$100 is non-refundable.

There is a coin-operated laundry facility in the housing (\$4 for wash/dry).

To get to work, staff can walk or take a free shuttle. All locations are close to bus stops and are 30 minutes or less from the resort. Inside the Town of Vail, buses are free, and outside the Town of Vail, buses are \$4 one way.

Transportation Information

Fly into Denver International Airport (land before 5:00 PM). A resort representative will pick up participants from the airport or there will be a free shuttle to the resort operated by Colorado Mountain Express.
