M/V Norstream rescued crew in the English Channel

During the night of 13th to 14th January 2017, M/V Norstream rescued the entire crew from M/V Fluvius Tamar who unfortunately sank. M/V Norstream got a Mayday call from the sinking vessel and also a request from Dover coastguard to proceed towards the scene of disaster. A helicopter assisted later to take all rescued persons to hospital, all crew survived. Thereafter, Norstream could continue towards Tilbury in their trade for P&O Ferries.

Håkan Modig, Bore CEO says; *"I'm proud to say that our crew performed very well in the stressful situation and the fairly bad weather conditions. It is always sad to hear about Mayday distress at sea, we are pleased that all crew could be rescued."*

John Garner, P&O Fleet Director states; *"The primary duty of any Master and seafarer is to assist mariners in distress who have declared Mayday. The Master and crew of Norstream have discharged this obligation in an excellent manner by rescuing the entire crew from M/V Fluvius Tamar which sank. Well done to all onboard."*
