

COOKIES AND PRIVACY POLICY

The law requires us to provide you with detailed information about the cookies that may be set when you visit our sites.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text strings that the websites visited send to the devices, where they are stored and relayed once the user visits the website again.

Cookies may perform different functions and have different features. Cookies can be used by Data Controller either by Third Parties.

Here below you'll find all the information related to cookies used by the present website, together with the instructions which will help you to manage your cookies preferences.

Some features on our website will not function if you do not allow cookies.

Cookies used by the FRED.FM website

Your continued use of the FRED.FM website means that you consent to our site using cookies. If you do not wish us to use cookies then please follow the instructions in the 'Changing your settings' section below. The following types of cookie are used on this site. We don't list every single cookie used by name - but for each type of cookie we tell you how you can control its use.

Technical cookies that don't require user consent:

Cookies used in order to perform activities strictly necessary for the functioning of the present website and for the provision of the service:

This Application uses Cookies to save the User's session and to carry out other activities that are strictly necessary for the operation of the same, for example in relation to the distribution of traffic.

Cookies used in order to save the user's preferences and to optimize website functions:

This Application uses Cookies to save browsing preferences and to optimize the User's browsing experience. Among these Cookies are, for example, those to set the language and the currency or for the management of first party statistics employed directly by the Owner of the site.

All cookies different from technical cookies above mentioned are installed / activate only after user prior express consent to be released on the first visit on the website. The consent may be expressed in general manner, by interact with cookie banner, according to the different modality explained in the banner (e.g. by click on OK button or X banner; by continuing the visit on the website, by scrolling down or link); otherwise the consent may be supplied / not supplied in a selective way, following the modalities below. Your consent will track in occasion of different and future website visits. User have, in any case, the right to revoke – at all or partially - your expressed consent.

Analytics cookies

These cookies allow us to count the total amount of page visits and sources of traffic so we can measure and improve the performance of our site. This is used so that we can see total (not individual) statistics on which types of content users listen to most, for example.

Third - party service cookies

We use a number of social sharing tools (for example, Twitter, Facebook) to make our websites to encourage visitor interaction. If you already use these social media platforms then their cookies may be set through our websites or mobile apps. They do this, not FRED.FM - it allows data to be collected by these companies which enables them to serve adverts on other sites that they think are relevant to your interests. If you do not use social media tools, then you won't pick up any of those kinds of cookies.

Third party Advertising

We sell space on some of our websites to Google AdSense- These cookies allow us to provide a high quality content you enjoy for free.

Google AdSense displays interest-based advertisements on this website. To determine your interests, Google will track your behaviour across the web using cookies. You can view, delete or add interest categories associated with your browser using [Google's Ads Preference Manager](#).
