Undeclared Wheat and Oats





What's happened?

We are recalling a limited number of cans and bottles of London Fields Brewery 'Hackney Hopster' beer as it contains wheat and oats, which are not declared on the product labels. This means that those products are a possible health risk to anyone with an allergy to wheat or oats. However, they are otherwise perfectly safe to drink.

Keg product sold in the on-trade (pubs and bars) is also incorrectly labelled. We have informed customers to advise consumers at the point of purchase that the product contains malted barley, wheat and oats, and new labels are being made available. This will prevent any need to recall keg product.

Which products are affected?

Hackney Hopster with a best before date prior to 04/12/19.

What should you do?
