GBGB NOTICE FOR TRAINERS

Veterinary Surgeons: Reducing the risk of race day positive samples

GBGB is concerned with the increasing number of positive samples resulting from cross-contamination, the use of unlicensed veterinary products, an over use of supplements, and the exposure of greyhounds to recreational drugs. The following advice should be closely followed to minimise the risk of contamination and exposing greyhounds to prohibited substances.

Guidelines for the Responsible Use of Medicines form part of the GBGB Rules of Racing (Rules 214 – 217) and trainers and staff should make themselves familiar with these rules. It is equally important that any veterinary surgeon prescribing medication to a greyhound is also familiar with Rule 216 (Treatment Book) and 217 (Administration of medicaments to Greyhounds).

‘Cross contamination’ risk can be reduced by recognising what might contain a prohibited substance and adopting a common-sense approach to controlling your dogs’ exposure to it. Smoking, eating or drinking near greyhounds can expose them to prohibited substances such as caffeine or theobromine. Human use of medication can cause a problem – trainers need to make their staff aware of how easily residues can be transferred and should take appropriate steps, such as wearing gloves when feeding or handling dogs if they are taking medication. The use of **inhalers** such as salbutamol, salmeterol, formoterol and vilanterol to treat asthma or lung conditions, **should not** be used around greyhounds as aerosolised medication increases the risk of cross contamination. Where dogs are medicated, extra care should be taken to prevent crossover of medicines between dogs kenneled together. Medicines must be stored and used in accordance with VMD (Veterinary Medicines Directorate) and GBGB Guidelines and their use must be recorded as per Rule 216; See:

Use of recreational drugs by staff can cause similar problems. The GBGB take all findings of drugs of abuse very seriously. Trainers should take precautions to avoid any exposure and the government has provided useful advice:

Withdrawal Time – the GBGB Rules of Racing (Rule 217) imposes Strict Liability on Trainers to ensure that “all greyhounds are free of any substance or medication that could affect its performance or well-being the origin of which cannot be traced to normal and ordinary feeding” when they are presented to race or trial.

The exceptions to the Rule are approved medicinal products for the suppression of oestrus, vaccines and anti-parasitic drugs licensed for use in dogs by the VMD and substances included in the GBGB list of Permitted Treatments.

The Rules specify a *minimum* mandatory 7-day period between administration of medicine and a race or trial. Certain medicines may persist for longer such as some long acting or depot preparations and veterinary advice should be sought if these are prescribed for use. Specifically,

meloxicam may persist for up to 25 days and should be avoided in dogs intended to race or trial within this timeframe.

Supplements can be an unintentional source of a prohibited substance. Care should be taken in their use – a significant proportion are not subject to quality control and the composition of their contents cannot always be relied upon. If multiple supplements are given, their ingredients can add up to exceed 'threshold' levels of substances normally found in the body, because these elevated levels then become prohibited. Human and equine supplements and herbal products are not recommended for use in dogs as their safety cannot be guaranteed.

Use of any unlicensed veterinary product is illegal, as is use of human medicines in animals, without a veterinary prescription, and not permitted under the Rules of Racing regardless of the claims made on the product. Internet availability of these products is putting trainers at risk because accurate advice is not usually available; your veterinary surgeon can advise on what is licensed for use in greyhounds in the UK and what is not. As with supplements, use of many unlicensed products increases risk of a 'positive' because they are very often not subject to quality control.

Only medicines licensed by the VMD for use in dogs may be used, and if any other medicines are used they must be used only under the prescription of a veterinary surgeon.

Day of race administration of, or exposure to, a prohibited substance is not permissible under the Rules of Racing and will increase the risk of a race day 'positive'.

Elective testing is an option if you have a concern about a specific substance in a specific greyhound which is entered to run.

DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE INQUIRIES

The Disciplinary Committee of the GBGB were in attendance at a meeting held on 19 January 2021:-

1 **Romford Stadium – SOBER EXPRESS – Professional Trainer Mr M Wallis**

Professional Trainer Mark Wallis was found in breach of rules 152 (i), 174 (i)(b) and 217 of the GBGB Rules of Racing in that a urine sample taken from the greyhound SOBER EXPRESS at Romford Stadium on 4 September 2020 was analysed by LGC Health Sciences as containing the presence of dorzolamide, and that he had in his charge a greyhound that showed the presence of a substance that by its nature could affect the performance of a greyhound or prejudice its wellbeing.

Mr Wallis was in attendance. Mark Arkell, racing manager of Romford Stadium, stipendiary steward, Robbie Steward, and Professor Tim Morris, independent scientific adviser, were also in attendance.

Mr Wallis admitted breaches of rules 152 (i), 174 (i)(b) and 217 of the GBGB Rules of Racing. GBGB withdrew the allegation of breach of 174(i)(a).

SOBER EXPRESS came into the care of Mr Wallis on 12 March 2020. SOBER EXPRESS had negative urine tests for dorzolamide on the following dates: at the point of registration

sample on 19 March 2020 and at a race day sample on 12 July 2020.

On 4 September 2020 urine sampling of SOBER EXPRESS before a race at Romford Stadium gave a positive result for dorzolamide when analysed by the laboratory LGC Health Sciences.

On 2 October 2020 a urine sample from SOBER EXPRESS was reported by the laboratory LGC as negative but with screening findings of dorzolamide but at a level insufficient to confirm. On 27 October 2020 a screening sample of urine taken from SOBER EXPRESS was reported negative, with possible screening indications that the sample contained weak evidence of dorzolamide but at a level insufficient to confirm.

The committee heard evidence given by Mr Wallis. Mr Wallis stated that - as submitted in his written statement - he had no idea how the substance dorzolamide had been detected in the urine sample from the dog SOBER EXPRESS taken at Romford Stadium on 4 September 2020. Mr Wallis believed that SOBER EXPRESS must have been exposed to the drug prior to coming into Mr Wallis' kennels in March 2020.

The committee heard evidence from Professor Tim Morris the key points of which were:

Dorzolamide is a human medicine used for the treatment of raised pressure in the eye (glaucoma) which is not licensed for use in dogs but may be prescribed by veterinary surgeons under the 'prescribing cascade' for use in dogs.

Dorzolamide is a substance which by its nature could affect the performance of a greyhound. There is limited evidence of the potential of dorzolamide to prejudice the well-being of a greyhound.

Dorzolamide was found in the urine sample taken from SOBER EXPRESS on 4 September 2020 but its source was not accounted for by Professor Morris' review of Mr Wallis' feeding regime for his greyhounds and treatment book and is therefore unknown.

That a single exposure of a dog to the drug dorzolamide can result in findings of this drug in a dog's urine for 545 days (as demonstrated by reference to the case of SENSIBLE MINNIE previously heard by the disciplinary committee).

In Professor Morris' opinion the amounts of dorzolamide found in the urine sample of SOBER EXPRESS taken on 4 September 2020 could indicate that the dog's primary exposure to the drug had been some considerable time before 4 September 2020, including before SOBER EXPRESS came into Mr Wallis' care OR could also indicate a lower level of exposure between 12 July 2020 and 4 September 2020.

That the pattern of urine tests from SOBER EXPRESS between 19 March 2020 and 27 October 2020 which gave results which were negative then positive then indicated possible weak evidence of dorzolamide but at a level insufficient to confirm (as described above) could be explained in the following ways:

(a) That detection of dorzolamide in a dog's urine can be sporadic

and / or

- (i) That detection capability of dorzolamide is not currently standardised between testing for different purposes (of particular relevance to the comparison of the point of registration sample, which is primarily to protect buyers, and subsequent positive sample, which is to control medication and doping, in this case). Such standardisation is being sought by GBGB.

The committee found that a urine sample taken from the greyhound SOBER EXPRESS at Romford Stadium on 4 September 2020 was analysed by LGC as containing the presence of dorzolamide, and that Mr Wallis as the trainer responsible for the dog SOBER EXPRESS was therefore in breach of the 'strict liability' rules 152 (i), 174 (i)(b) and 217 of the GBGB Rules of Racing.

However, the committee felt that on the balance of probabilities the positive test was the result of SOBER EXPRESS having been exposed to dorzolamide before the dog came into Mr Wallis' care.

The committee heard that there were some previous breaches of the rules by Mr Wallis, but since the committee felt that on the balance of probabilities the positive test was the result of SOBER EXPRESS having been exposed to dorzolamide before the dog came into Mr Wallis' care 'No further action' was recorded.

2 Peterborough Stadium – KYNREN – Professional Trainer Mr P Braithwaite

Professional Trainer Paul Braithwaite was found in breach of rules 152 (i) and (ii), 174 (i)(a) and 217 of the GBGB Rules of Racing in that a urine sample taken from the greyhound KYNREN at Peterborough Stadium on 4 March 2020 was analysed by LGC Health Sciences as containing the presence of azaperone and metabolites of azaperone and azaperol; and that he allowed a substance to be administered that could affect the performance and/or wellbeing of the greyhound.

Mr Braithwaite was in attendance. Stipendiary stewards, Dave Baldwin and Tiffany Blackett, and Professor Tim Morris, independent scientific adviser, were also in attendance.

Mr Braithwaite admitted breaches of the 'strict liability' rules 152 (i), 174 (i)(b) and 217 of the GBGB Rules of Racing. Mr Braithwaite did not admit breach of rule 174(i)(a).

On 4 March 2020 the dog KYNREN won the race by 2½ lengths recording a calculated time of 26.90 seconds. This was a significant improvement on his performance during his trial 5 days earlier of 27.36 seconds. He was also reported to have been crowded at the first bend during the race on 4 March 2020.

The committee heard evidence given by Mr Braithwaite. Mr Braithwaite stated that – as submitted in his written statement – he believed that the positive test for azaperol found in the urine sample of KYNREN taken at Peterborough stable on 4 March 2020 must have been the result of KYNREN eating Category 2 meat which was intended for the retired greyhounds in Mr Braithwaite's kennels. Such meat must, in Mr Braithwaite's view, have been contaminated with azaperone or metabolites of azaperone and azaperol.

Mr Braithwaite provided in evidence details of his feeding regimes for all of his dogs, and receipts for the supply to Mr Braithwaite of Category 2 beef by Redfern and Sons of Derbyshire. When questioned by the committee Mr Braithwaite agreed that he had no record of having been supplied with pork.

When questioned by Mr Gibson, Mr Braithwaite stated that he had no knowledge of the use or misuse of azaperone in racing greyhounds and had not heard of the drug before KYNREN's positive test on 4 March 2020.

When questioned by members of the committee, Mr Braithwaite was not able to explain the marked improvement in KYNREN's performance in his race on 4 March 2020 compared to his performance in his trial 5 days earlier, though Mr Braithwaite agreed that the trial had been 'disappointing'.

The committee heard evidence from Professor Tim Morris, the key points of which were:

Azaperone is a sedative licensed for use in pigs only. Azaperone is not licensed for use in dogs. Azaperone if used in dogs would have a sedative effect.

Azaperone and azaperol, with their sedative effects and with azaperol as an active metabolite of azaperone, are substances which by their nature could affect the performance of a greyhound and could, especially at higher doses, prejudice the wellbeing of a greyhound.

Professor Morris could see nothing in the treatment book records supplied and medication reported that would explain the finding of azaperol in the urine sample taken from KYNREN on 4 March 2020.

Professor Morris could find nothing in the feed given to Mr Braithwaite's greyhounds that would explain the finding of azaperol in the urine sample taken from KYNREN on 4 March 2020. In particular, Professor Morris noted that azaperone is licensed only for use in pigs and it is therefore unlikely that azaperone would be found as a residue in Category Animal By Products from cattle. Professor Morris also noted that beef and pork meat are clearly distinguishable.

Professor Morris concluded that azaperol had been found in the urine sample taken from KYNREN on 4 March 2020 and that the likely source was exposure to azaperone.

Professor Morris noted that the finding of metabolites but not the parent drug azaperone in the urine sample could indicate that exposure to the drug azaperone had occurred before 4 March 2020.

In view of the scientific and other evidence presented, the committee did not find Mr Braithwaite's argument that the positive finding of azaperol in the urine sample taken from KYNREN on 4 March 2020 must have been due to contamination of meat which had been mistakenly fed to KYNREN to be credible.

On the balance of probabilities, the committee found that there had been a deliberate administration of the sedative drug azaperone to the dog KYNREN.

The committee therefore found Mr Braithwaite to be in breach of rules 152 (i)&(ii), 174 (i)(a) and 217 of the GBGB Rules of Racing.

Mr Braithwaite gave evidence that he "had never heard of azaperone" until the Inquiry and had had to "google" the substance. However, the committee heard that amongst Mr Braithwaite's previous breaches had been one for a positive sample for azaperone in 2001.

The committee applied a sanction for the breaches of rules committed by Mr Braithwaite, as follows: disqualification for an indefinite period, suspended for two years, and a fine of £1,000.

3 Nottingham Stadium – POWER MOTION – Professional Trainer Mr J Gray

Professional Trainer Jason Gray was found in breach of rules 152 (i), 174 (i)(b) and 217 of the GBGB Rules of Racing in that a urine sample taken from the greyhound POWER MOTION at Nottingham Stadium on 16 June 2020 was analysed by LGC Health Sciences as containing the presence of 5 α -estrane-17 α -ethynyl-3 β ,17 β -diol and 5 β -,estrane-17 α ethynyl-3 α ,17 β -diol, and that he had in his charge a greyhound that showed the presence of a substance that by its nature could affect the performance of a greyhound or prejudice its wellbeing.

Mr Gray was in attendance. Jason Smith, racing manager of Nottingham Stadium, and Professor Tim Morris, independent scientific adviser, were also in attendance.

Mr Gray admitted breaches of the 'strict liability' rules 152 (i), 174 (i) (b) and 217 of the GBGB Rules of Racing. Mr Gray did not admit breach of rule 174 (i)(a).

A urine sample taken from the male greyhound POWER MOTION at Nottingham stadium on 16 June 2020 was analysed by LGC and found to contain norethisterone metabolites.

The Veterinary Medicines Directorate has confirmed that norethisterone may be prescribed by veterinary surgeons exercising their clinical judgement under the 'prescribing cascade' to provide long term suppression of oestrus in racing greyhound bitches.

The use / presence of norethisterone in a male racing greyhound would be a breach of Rule 217 of the GBGB Rules of Racing.

The committee heard evidence given by Mr Gray. Mr Gray believed – as stated in his written submission – that the presence of norethisterone metabolites in urine sample taken from POWER MOTION on 16 June 2020 must have been attributable to POWER MOTION having ingested norethisterone which had been prescribed by a veterinary surgeon for oestrus suppression of POWER MOTION's kennel mate, the bitch NIKITA JAXX.

The committee reviewed documentary evidence provided by Mr Gray including his greyhound treatment book, receipts for norethisterone supply from Fulbeck Veterinary Services, and kennel lists of suppressed bitches.

The committee questioned Mr Gray about the feeding regimes for his greyhounds. Mr Gray explained that norethisterone tablets are fed to each bitch individually by hand rather than being included in food. However, POWER MOTION is a big greedy dog and he suspected that the dog had either consumed the bitch's vomit or licked her urine. He went on to state that the given of the suppressant tablets was now undertaken only by himself or his head lad and was no longer delegated to kennel staff.

The committee heard evidence from Professor Tim Morris, the key points of which were:

Norethisterone is a human-made form of progesterone. There is no licensed veterinary preparation of norethisterone.

Norethisterone is a substance which by its nature could, in Professor Morris' opinion, when given to a male dog affect the performance of the greyhound or prejudice the wellbeing of the greyhound.

Norethisterone metabolites were found in the urine sample taken from POWER MOTION on 16 June 2020 and analysed by LGC.

The presence of norethisterone metabolites in the urine sample taken from POWER MOTION on 16 June 2020 probably originated from ingestion of norethisterone by POWER MOTION.

The circumstances of this ingestion were unknown: there was nothing in the feeding regime or treatment book which would explain the presence of norethisterone metabolites in the urine sample taken from POWER MOTION on 16 June 2020.

The committee discussed with Professor Morris the likelihood of the presence of norethisterone metabolites in the urine sample of a greyhound resulting from that greyhound having either eaten the vomit or licked the urine of a bitch which had been treated with norethisterone. Professor Morris' opinion was that the dog licking the bitch's urine was unlikely to give a positive sample through effects of its dilution.

In view of the scientific and other evidence presented the committee felt that on the balance of probabilities the presence of norethisterone metabolites in the urine sample taken from POWER MOTION on 16 June 2020 probably originated from ingestion by POWER MOTION of norethisterone which had

been prescribed for his kennel mate, the bitch NIKITA JAXX.

The committee therefore found Mr Gray to be in breach of 'strict liability' rules 152 (i), 174 (i)(b) and 217 of the GBGB Rules of Racing. Since Mr Gray feeds norethisterone to the bitches in his kennels by hand rather than by including the medicine in their feed Rule 214 was not applicable.

The committee heard that there had been no previous breaches of the rules by Mr Gray, and that Mr Gray always makes his greyhounds available at the track in a fit and well manner.

The committee applied a sanction for the breaches of rules committed by Mr Gray, as follows: a caution and £100 fine.

Further note

The committee asked that GBGB publish again in the Calendar advice for trainers on best practice to avoid cross-contamination between dogs when using oral drugs for the suppression of oestrus in greyhound bitches.

LOCAL INQUIRIES

1 Doncaster Stadium – Professional Trainer RICKY OVERTON

At a local inquiry held by the Senior Stipendiary Steward on 21 December 2020 professional trainer Mr R Overton was cautioned and fined £100 for a breach of Rules 152(i) and 174(xii)(a) in respect of acting in an improper manner as a licence holder at Doncaster Stadium on 8 December 2020

2 Henlow Stadium – SLIPPY SCARLETT

At a local inquiry held by the Area Stipendiary Steward on 10 December 2020, professional trainer Mrs MP Brown was cautioned and fined £100 for a breach of Rule 49(iv) in respect of the improved performance of the greyhound SLIPPY SCARLETT at Henlow Stadium on 5 November 2020 and her failure to use her best endeavours to ensure that the performance of the greyhound was to the satisfaction of the Stewards.

Opening and starting at 2/1, the greyhound had won a 460m race recording a calculated time of 28.35 seconds as compared with its best recent time of 29.34 seconds recorded in a trial on 26 October 2020.

3 Monmore Green Stadium – FEORA JESSIE

At a local inquiry held by the Area Stipendiary Steward on 17 November 2020, professional trainer Mr CD Marston's explanation was accepted in respect of the improved performance of the greyhound FEORA JESSIE at Monmore Green Stadium on 3 August 2020.

Opening and Starting at 7/2, the greyhound had won a 480m race recording a calculated time of 28.86 seconds as compared with its best recent time of 29.39 seconds recorded in a trial on 28 July 2020.

4 Nottingham Stadium – Kennelhand PHILIP GOWER

At a local inquiry held by the Area Stipendiary Steward on 26 November 2020 kennelhand Mr P Gower was cautioned for a breach of Rules 152(i) and 174(xii)(a) in respect of acting in an improper manner as a licence holder at Nottingham Stadium on 5 November 2020.

5 Sheffield Stadium – HAVING A GIGGLE

At a local inquiry held by the Area Stipendiary Steward on 10 November 2020, professional trainer Mr JD Davy was cautioned for a breach of Rule 49(iv) in respect of the improved performance of the greyhound HAVING A GIGGLE at Sheffield Stadium on 25 August 2020 and his failure to use his best endeavours to ensure that the performance of the greyhound was to the satisfaction of the Stewards.

Opening at 2/1 and Starting at 7/4F, the greyhound had won a 500m race recording a calculated time of 29.96 seconds as compared with its best recent time of 30.60 seconds recorded in a trial on 11 August 2020.

6 Sheffield Stadium – UH OH STINKY

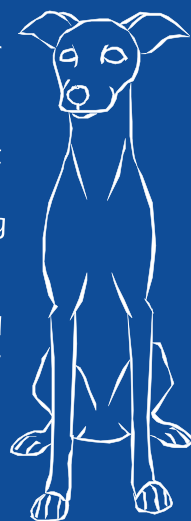

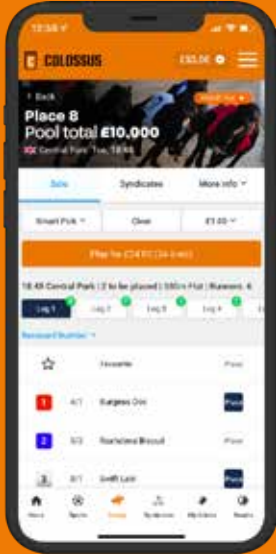

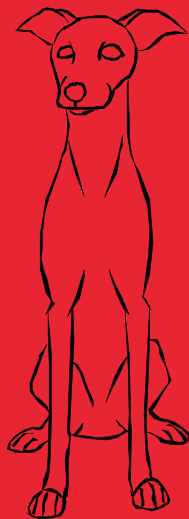
