1 KETOPROFEN POSITIVES

The Disciplinary Committee received reports of four positive samples for ketoprofen and/or a ketoprofen metabolite taken on the following dates:

- 11 August 2020 – Central Park Stadium – DECISIVE FRANCO – Professional Trainer Mr M Fenwick
- 2 October 2020 – Nottingham Stadium – LITTLE EMIR – Professional Trainer Mr G Carmichael
- 10 June 2019 – Sheffield Stadium – INCA SAPPHIRE – Professional Trainer Mr P Barlow
- 16 June 2020 – Sheffield Stadium – GUSSY GOOSE – Greyhound Trainer Mr A Lumb

The trainers concerned had been advised by the Director of Regulation that it was not necessary for them to attend the hearing. The trainers had been given the option to attend if they wished, and informed that non-attendance would not be prejudicial to any future proceedings that may take place at the direction of the Disciplinary Committee.

The four above cases involving samples which identified the presence of ketoprofen and/or a ketoprofen metabolite were the subject of individual Preliminary

Inquiries (between June 2019 and October 2020) but were not considered by the Disciplinary Committee pending the outcome of an administration study sponsored by the GBGB to determine Screening Limits for ketoprofen and its' metabolite. That study has now been completed and Screening and Residue Limits established.

The background to the need for an administration study into ketoprofen was explained by Professor Morris as follows:

Ketoprofen is used in animals and man. For animals it is available as a UK licensed veterinary medicine, in tablet or injectable form, from a number of different companies, for therapeutic indications in a number of species including dogs, cattle, horses and pigs. A number of tablet or topical (gel) preparations are used in human medicine.

Ketoprofen chemically is in the class of drugs described as Non-Steroidal Anti-inflammatory Drugs (NSAIDs). NSAIDs relieve pain, reduce fever and reduce inflammation. All NSAIDs have the potential to induce adverse reactions, some of which can be life threatening.

Professor Morris was not aware of any studies that show ketoprofen could directly affect the performance of a greyhound but the alleviation of symptoms by ketoprofen could have an indirect effect on performance by mitigating adverse effects of any pain or inflammation.

Accordingly, in Professor Morris's opinion ketoprofen as a NSAID is a substance which by its nature could affect the performance of the

Greyhound or could prejudice the wellbeing of a greyhound.

Substances prohibited in racing include therapeutic substances used for the treatment of greyhounds at all concentrations ("strict liability"). Screening Limits (SLs) have been agreed for some of these substances and increasingly are internationally harmonised following cooperation between greyhound racing regulators. As greyhounds may be fed meat, some of which may contain residue of these therapeutic substances, these limits may also serve as Residue Limits (RLs). The SL or RL is the urine or plasma concentration adopted for the laboratory screening of a specified therapeutic prohibited substance; it is derived from data from administration and other studies followed by a risk analysis consisting of two components: risk assessment (evaluation of the effect of the substance and factors related to its control) and risk management (decision step for harmonisation).

There has been insufficient existing data to derive a SL and RL for ketoprofen, it was also unclear whether metabolites of ketoprofen would be found in the urine of dogs, and in the first instance, considerable costs would be incurred to obtain such data.

However, in recent years, it has become clear that such a study and its analysis was required. Although the use of ketoprofen as a NSAID for the treatment of dogs has now greatly declined, there remains the possibility of exposure. This is because the food safety assessment

of ketoprofen indicates a very low risk to consumers via meat.

Unusually, after safety assessment, it had been determined by the relevant authorities that there is no food safety maximum residue limit required in law and therefore ketoprofen would not be tested for in the routine monitoring of meat for drug residues for human safety. While the GBGB continues to advise against the feeding of Category 2 animal by products to racing greyhounds the Board was concerned that it was possible that meat containing some ketoprofen residues legally enters the supply chain for human consumption or Category 3 Animal By Products, and very low levels are detected in greyhounds fed this meat as food.

A specific ketoprofen administration study, laboratory analysis of these samples, and the subsequent pharmacokinetic analysis was therefore commissioned, and has now been completed. A SL and RL for ketoprofen has now been produced in November 2020. It has been clarified that a metabolite is produced in dogs, and there is now also a SL and RL for the main ketoprofen metabolite in dogs.

In lay terms this means that the Board has been able to advance the science of the reporting of low levels of ketoprofen and its' metabolite resulting inadvertently from feeding meat or Category 3 animal by products to racing greyhounds. In future, positive samples showing a measure below the SL and RL will not be individually reported.

Accordingly, while the Disciplinary Committee in the 4 above reported cases found the Trainers in breach of the "strict liability" rules 152(i), 174(i) (b) and 217 of the rules of racing they determined that it was appropriate to take no further action as there was a probability that the positive samples resulted from Category 3 meat (Note – in the matter of case 3 above it was noted that it was not possible to confirm the precise level of the ketoprofen metabolite but in all the circumstances the Committee deemed it appropriate to treat this case as the others).

2 Nottingham Stadium – DEADLY STORM – Professional Trainer Mr G McEntee

Professional Trainer Gerry McEntee was found in breach of rules 152 (i), 174 (i)(b) and 217 of the GBGB Rules of Racing in that a urine sample

taken from the greyhound DEADLY STORM at Nottingham Stadium on 2 October 2020 was analysed by LGC Health Sciences as containing the presence of cimetidine, and that he had in his charge a greyhound that showed the presence of a substance that by its nature could affect the performance of a greyhound or prejudice its wellbeing.

Mr McEntee was in attendance. Stipendiary Stewards, Alex McTaggart and Tiffany Blackett, and Professor Tim Morris, independent scientific adviser, were also in attendance.

The Disciplinary Committee heard evidence from Professor Morris that cimetidine is available as a veterinary medicine in the United Kingdom for use in dogs but not farm animals or horses. Human medical preparations are also available in oral, including over-the-counter, and injectable forms. Cimetidine has an action in dogs, as in other species, in reducing gastric acid production and is indicated for the symptomatic treatment of gastritis in dogs. The alleviation of symptoms by cimetidine could have an indirect effect by mitigating adverse effect of any gastritis on performance. In relative terms its side effects are limited in dogs. In Professor Morris's opinion cimetidine, as an inhibitor of gastric acid secretion, is a substance which by its nature would not directly affect the performance of the greyhound and would have been of benefit to the wellbeing of a greyhound requiring treatment. However, no greyhound should race while suffering from gastritis.

The Committee heard from Mr McEntee that he had achieved a "lifetime" ambition by having a dog accepted for the English Greyhound Derby. Twice he had made the long journey from his kennels near Glasgow to Nottingham to trial DEADLY STORM and the dog had competed in heat 3 of the First Round. There were no suggestions of any betting irregularity but the dog had finished last after being crowded.

Professor Morris said that there was nothing in Mr McEntee's feeding regime or treatment book which could explain the presence of cimetidine and the scientific evidence suggested that exposure to cimetidine was likely to have been within the 7 days preceding DEADLY STORM's race. The indication of a metabolite further suggested that the cimetidine had been through

the dog i.e. not by way of cross-contamination.

Mr McEntee was a credible witness who was at a loss to explain the presence of cimetidine in the dog's sample. He stated that he was entirely unfamiliar with the substance. At the time DEADLY STORM was the only dog in Mr McEntee's kennel and only he and his wife had access to it. He denied administering cimetidine or Tagamet (the common Trade Name) and suggested that his only explanation was that the dog might have ingested a stray tablet in the week before the race. The dog had not suffered from gastritis (for which cimetidine would have been a treatment) at any time and was a good traveller requiring no medication for the long journey from Glasgow to Nottingham. He questioned the integrity of the sampling procedure at Nottingham on the night of the race but had not raised this issue at the Preliminary Inquiry.

The Committee was concerned that this positive sample had occurred during the sport's premier competition and made clear to Mr McEntee that only he and his wife could know in all likelihood how the cimetidine came to be in DEADLY STORM. The Committee noted Mr McEntee's references which included that of Alex McTaggart who spoke in his favour. However, although the Committee considered that it could not conclude that there had been a deliberate administration in this case or that Mr McEntee's kennel management had been recklessly deficient he nevertheless had ultimate responsibility as the licensed Trainer. For the breaches of rules of racing 152(i), 174(i)(b) and 217 Mr McEntee was cautioned and fined £250.

1 Romford Stadium: SMALLMEAD - Professional Greyhound Trainer Mr John Mullins

Professional Greyhound Trainer Mr John Mullins was found in breach of rules 152(i), 174(i)(b) and 217 of the GBGB rules of racing in that a urine sample taken from the greyhound SMALLMEAD at Romford

Stadium on 18 September 2020 was analysed by LGC Health Sciences as containing the presence of procaine, a substance that by its nature could prejudice the well-being of a greyhound.

Mr Mullins was in attendance, represented by Mr Howard Berlin. Mr Mark Arkell, Racing Manager at Romford Stadium and Professor Tim Morris, independent scientific adviser, were also in attendance.

The Committee heard that SMALLMEAD had started as 4/6 favourite in the Champion Stakes Final at Romford Stadium on 18 September 2020. It won by a short head in a time of 34.92. As with all Category 1 finalists, a pre-race urine sample was taken, which tested positive for the presence of procaine.

Professor Morris told the Committee that procaine was used in veterinary medicine in two ways: it was available as a prescription-only injectable local anaesthetic for use in a number of species including farm animals and dogs; and it was combined with penicillin to extend the duration of the action of that antibiotic in a prescription only injection. It was also a less commonly used prescription-only medicine for people. In dogs as in other animals and humans, procaine was a local anaesthetic. It could stimulate a dog's central nervous system. Other constituents in procaine products could cause side effects such as tissue damage from reduced blood supply. It was a substance which, in Professor Morris's opinion, could affect the performance of a greyhound and could prejudice the wellbeing of a greyhound.

Professor Morris's evidence was that there were realistically four possible sources for procaine. It could come from veterinary procaine injected as a local anaesthetic into the greyhound or via a residue from treated animals whose meat had been eaten by the greyhound. It could come from an injection of penicillin combined with procaine injected into the greyhound or via a residue from treated animals whose meat had been eaten by the greyhound. Thirdly, it could come from exposure to procaine prescribed for human use as an anaesthetic or a penicillin and procaine compound. Finally, procaine was available from specialist chemical suppliers.

In evidence, Professor Morris described the first two possibilities as "primary possibilities". These were much the more likely sources of the

procaine detected in SMALLMEAD's sample.

Professor Morris said LGC had informed him that a concentration of between 2µg/mL and 4µg/mL of procaine had been detected in the sample taken from SMALLMEAD and that there was no evidence of the presence of penicillin.

Professor Morris referred to the findings of a 1983 study on procaine detected in the urine of racing greyhounds which reported on the rate at which procaine was excreted after either the greyhound was injected with procaine or the combination of procaine and penicillin or the greyhound was fed meat from an animal that had been injected with procaine or the combination. Professor Morris said the results of this study indicated that SMALLMEAD had probably been exposed to procaine between 48 hours and 24 hours before the pre-race sample was taken, and probably nearer to 24 hours.

Mr Mullins's told the Local Inquiry held on 20 October 2020 and the Committee that he had not and would never give a banned substance to any greyhound and he was not responsible for procaine being detected in the sample taken from SMALLMEAD.

Mr Mullins's evidence was that at the date of the sample he was feeding only Category 3, unstained meat to all his racing dogs, retired dogs and puppies. He bought this from a supplier he had used for many years and which had supplied his mother before him. He produced receipts from the supplier showing that in the relevant period he was receiving Category 3 meat and a letter from the supplier confirming that they had followed instructions given by Mr Mullins that the meat he received should be only beef and should contain no horsemeat.

Mr Mullins described how he had the meat delivered in large pieces which he would take from the freezer and cook each day as required. Starting at 6am, he cooked the meat by boiling in a copper with stock and vegetables for about three hours, when he would cut it into smaller pieces and then cook it at boiling point for another hour. The meat would remain in the copper until midday when he would mince it finely before feeding it to his dogs.

Professor Morris's evidence was that penicillin became unstable in temperatures above 37°C. In

contrast procaine was stable at boiling temperatures. The presence of penicillin could well not have been detected in the sample from SMALLMEAD because the antibiotic had been broken down by the vigorous boiling described and shown in a video clip produced by Mr Mullins.

Professor Morris said that on a simple comparison with the results from the 1983 study, leaving out of account all the possible different circumstances, the level of procaine detected in SMALLMEAD's sample made administration of procaine or of the combination of procaine and penicillin to the dog a more likely explanation than that the dog had been fed procaine-contaminated meat. However, the 1983 study was just one study, carried out on a relatively small number of greyhounds. He would be cautious about narrowly relying on it as showing administration was the more likely cause.

Professor Morris said that Category 3 meat should not contain drug residues. He confirmed in evidence that, for this reason, it was considered "low risk". However, he said that there was a difference in risk between obtaining Category 3 meat from a supplier that was only processing meat for human consumption and from a supplier (such as Mr Mullins's) that was also processing Category 1 and Category 2 meat. The risk was two-fold: the meat supplied might not be Category 3 meat, or it might be Category 3 meat contaminated with Category 2 meat during processing. It was fair to say that the Committee had had a number of cases where meat supplied by other suppliers as Category 3 meat was found to have contained drug residues.

Mr Arkell, Racing Manager at Romford Stadium, told the Committee that SMALLMEAD had run to form in the Champion Stakes Final. Considering the PA Sport lines, Mr Arkell noted that it had won its heats and a series of races preceding the Final. It had gone on to record a number of good performances following the Final, including trials at Nottingham and Crayford before winning the Kent St Leger Consolation Final and the St Leger over 710 metres at Perry Barr. It had been running every week and its performances had been very consistent.

Professor Morris told the Committee that the only obvious reason to

administer a local anaesthetic like procaine to a greyhound would be to treat an injury, either from good intentions or to "mask" that injury, enabling it to run to its capacity despite being injured. Questioned by Mr Berlin, Professor Morris explained that using the anaesthetic could be the way an injured greyhound was enabled to run consistently at short intervals.

In his evidence to the Committee, Mr Mullins said he had been involved with training greyhounds his whole life. He had not and never would administer a banned substance to a greyhound. He had not injected SMALLMEAD with procaine. He questioned why he would have risked doing this when, like all trainers, he knew all runners in a Category 1 final would be tested. If the greyhound had run injured in the Champion Stakes Final, it would have been injured after that race. But SMALLMEAD had gone on to run in a trial at Nottingham five days later and run in the Kent St Leger before being eliminated in the semi-finals and then won the St Leger at Perry Barr.

Following the evidence, Director of Regulation Mark Bird said it was accepted that Mr Mullins had not administered procaine or allowed it to be administered to SMALLMEAD and that the probable explanation for the positive test result was that the greyhound had been fed meat which, despite being bought as Category 3 meat, had been contaminated with a residue of procaine. Mr Bird said that Mr Mullins had been unlucky but was in breach of Rule 174 (i) (b) and Rule 217, which imposed strict liability, and as a consequence of those breaches he was in breach of Rule 152 (i).

For Mr Mullins, Mr Berlin submitted that while it had always been accepted that, through no fault on his part, Mr Mullins was in breach of Rule 174 (i) (b), he was not in breach of Rule 217 because if the procaine came from the meat fed to SMALLMEAD it was not, for the purposes of that rule, a substance "the origin of which could not be traced to normal and ordinary feeding".

The Committee agreed with the Board. It found Mr Mullins to be an honest witness who had co-operated with the Board in its investigation and in explaining the circumstances in which this positive test result had occurred. The Committee was entirely satisfied that this was not a case of deliberate administration

and that the explanation for the positive sample was the inadvertent feeding of meat contaminated by being from an animal treated with procaine as an anaesthetic or in combination with penicillin. Mr Mullins had done as much as he could reasonably be expected to do in sourcing and preparing meat to feed his greyhounds. He had been very unlucky. Through no fault on his part, he was in breach of Rule 174 (i) (b) and Rule 217. The Committee did not accept Mr Berlin's interpretation of Rule 217. Feeding contaminated meat, even inadvertently, was not "normal and ordinary feeding". Necessarily, Mr Mullins was also in breach of Rule 152 (i).

The Committee noted that following this positive test result Mr Mullins had decided to feed only meat sold for human consumption to his open racing dogs for a few days before every race day. In all the circumstances, the Committee agreed with Mr Bird for the Board that the right order in this case was that there be no further action.
