Absences and Lateness

As you will see from the schedule, there are a number of rehearsals spread throughout the coming months, leading to the performances in 2022. In order to create a 'team attitude' and ensure an excellent experience for all those taking part, we do require a high level of commitment from everyone; we ask that no participant misses more than 3 pre-notified or un-notified non-consecutive absences.

We also understand that we need to be flexible in current times due to COVID-19. If you have been told to self-isolate due to COVID-19 and will miss rehearsals at any time in the project, please let the Learning & Engagement team know as soon as possible.

If this limit is exceeded for any reason other than having to self-isolate due to COVID-19, the artistic team will decide whether you can continue with the project, on a case-by-case basis. It can be really difficult to catch up if you miss rehearsals and we want to make sure you're feeling as confident as possible with the show when you take to the stage with us.

If you are at all concerned or have any questions about this please do not hesitate to contact the Learning & Engagement department.

There may be unanticipated changes to the schedule if we have to accommodate revisions in the UK Government COVID-19 guidelines for singing and performing; we'll keep you up-to-date of any disruptions as soon as we have them - this might involve some short notice amendments depending when guidance is issued.
