 - **In the ear** • **On the main stalk** • **In the roots**
4. Which part of the wheat grain would grow into a new wheat plant?
 - **The bran** • **The wheatgerm** • **The endosperm**
5. Which part of the wheat grain is used to make white flour?
 - **The bran** • **The wheatgerm** • **The endosperm**
6. 'Gristing' happens at the mill. What does 'gristing' mean?
 - **Washing the grain before it is ground**
 - **Mixing different types of wheat to make different kinds of flour**
 - **Softening the bran layer so it's easier to remove the endosperm**
7. What is brown flour made from?
 - **About 85% of the original grain, but with some bran and germ removed**
 - **The endosperm only**
 - **All parts of the grain: endosperm, wheatgerm and bran layer**
