## Do your own thing

Bring your own gourmet picnic, bag the best spot and have your own idyll. Sit under an apple tree in the Walled Orchard, or by the Crinkle-Crankle Wall or in the woods . . . the possibilities are endless.

## Porter £25

The porter will carry your hamper from the car park to your picnic spot. *Once you have parked your car, walk towards the house and your porter will be waiting for you. This is a one-way service which should be booked in advance.*

## Reserved places in a marquee £15 per person

There is a marquee on the Croquet Lawn (by the Catalpa tree) and two more in the Orchard.

## Reserve an Indian pavilion £135

Dotted around the place (see map) are 19 Indian pavilions (4m diameter) made in Jodhpur. They have four fixed sides and two sides that can be attached in case of English weather. They seat 8-12.

## Crockery £15 per person

Includes 2 glasses, 3 plates, cutlery, coffee cup, napkins.

If you have people helping serve your picnic, please book a pair of pavilions next to one another.

**Stay within your limits . . .** we would be grateful if you could make your picnic fit inside your tent so others may enjoy the setting. If you bring your own furniture, it can only be used at the east end of the orchard.
