

Primary Teachers Workshop Terms and Conditions 2020

Introduction

This workshop is an introduction to teaching basic gymnastics skills in a school setting. The skills are applicable to all ages and ability. The workshop will cover technical progressions and development for the key curriculum-based skills and offer fundamental ideas for teachers to use. It is practical based, and the core objective is to improve the candidate's knowledge and confidence for teaching gymnastics in their school.

This 4-hour practical-based workshop is accredited by Gymnastics Ireland and candidates are awarded a Certificate of Attendance on completion of the workshop.

Booking

Eligibility

- All candidates must hold a current qualification in Primary Teaching or be in a current education pathway to Teaching.

Attire

- As the workshops are predominantly practical in nature, all candidates are required to wear suitable exercise attire e.g. leggings/ tracksuit and runners. **Candidates who are not suitably dressed will not be permitted to take part in the practical.**
- Long hair must be tied up (male and female)
- No Jewellery is permitted e.g. rings, necklaces and watches must be removed)

Insurance

- Workshop Candidates and tutor are covered by GI's Public Liability Insurance during workshop hours.

Certification

- This workshop is certified through Gymnastics Ireland and is designed to provide Primary Teachers with an opportunity to gain professional development in gymnastics.
- Candidates must complete the full 4 hours to gain certification.

Please note: All names must be sent to Gymnastics Ireland at least one week prior to the workshop. Certificates will be emailed directly to the school/ individual candidate on completion of the workshop.

Attendance

- 100% attendance on each workshop is required to gain certification.

Medical Consent

- All candidates signing up to a Gymnastics Ireland workshop give permission to be given medical treatment by a qualified practitioner.
- Workshop candidates consent to being taken to see a doctor or hospital in the case of an emergency.

Photographs or Video Permission

- All candidates on Gymnastics Ireland workshops may be used in photographs for promotional purposes by Gymnastics Ireland. If any candidate does not wish to be photographed or videos for promotional purposes, they must express this to the lead tutor prior to the commencement of the workshop.

Workshop Venue

- The organisation/ school is responsible of booking the venue and covering any costs. A normal school PE hall should be sufficient.
- The venue must be fit for purpose, with ample gymnastics mats and benches (see below for more details) and seating for the theory (approx. 20 mins).
- Access to a plug point and suitable area for laptop, projector and screen to be set up.

Required Equipment

- Matting that is suitable for rolling e.g. gymnastics mats **Quantity will depend on the number of participants and types of matting e.g. one mat per 4 participants*
- Benches (school-type benches are enough). *Approx. 5 required*
- Hoops and bean bags

Workshop Refreshments

- This is at the discretion of the participating organisation/school/ workshop facilitator

Cancellations

- In the unlikely event that Gymnastics Ireland is forced to cancel a workshop, organisations will receive a full refund, or a new date will be agreed and set with Gymnastics Ireland and the organisation.

Damages/ Injuries/ Loss of Possessions

- Gymnastics Ireland will not be held responsible for damages, injuries or loss/ damage to possessions. Due to the practical nature of these workshops candidates will be asked to actively participate within the session.

Data Protection and Privacy

Information provided will be collated and processed for:

- Certification through Gymnastics Ireland
- The operation and administration of education workshops are organised by Gymnastics Ireland
- The provision of attendee statistics to relevant third parties e.g. Sport Ireland. These will be statistics which will involve numbers and gender only – all candidates information will be anonymised prior to use.
- Research into the development of future sports inclusion policies.
