

Privacy Policy H&S Group

H&S Group B.V. (hereafter called 'H&S') is pleased that you visit our website and that you are interested in our company and our services. It is important to us to protect your personal data at all times.

Below we explain what information H&S can collect when you visit our website and how this information will be used.

Personal data

'Personal data' refers to specific information that can be traced back to an individual natural person, being you. These data include information such as your real name, address, telephone number and date of birth. Information which cannot be linked directly to your real identity is not considered personal data.

Collection and processing of personal data

H&S is committed to preserving the privacy of our website visitors. When you visit our web pages, our web servers always temporarily save the connection data of the computer connecting to our site for security purposes. These data can be but are not limited to a list of the pages that you visit on our website, the date and duration of your visit, the identification data of the browser and operating system you use, as well as the website through which you landed on our site. Additional personal information such as your name, address, telephone number or e-mail address is not collected unless you provide these data voluntarily, e.g. while completing an online contact form, as part of a registration or an information request.

Certain areas of the H&S website including, but not limited to, H&S portals require registration in order to access the site using a unique login name and password. H&S provides you the right of access and rectification of your personal data.

Security

H&S takes all of the necessary technical and organizational security measures to protect your personal data from being lost or misused. For instance, your data are saved in a secure operating environment which is not accessible to the public. In certain cases, your personal data are encrypted by Secure Socket Layer technology (SSL) during transmission. This means that an approved encryption procedure is used for communication between your computer and the H&S servers, provided your browser supports SSL.

Should you contact H&S by e-mail, we would like to point out that the confidentiality of the information sent cannot be guaranteed. The contents of e-mail messages can be read by third parties. We therefore recommend that you send us confidential information only by regular mail.

Right to information

Upon a written request to info@hs-group.eu, we will inform you what personal data we have saved from you. By sending an email to that same address, you can also request your data to be removed.
