



Things will be different for a while longer...

- We encourage you to make a table booking for each visit and we may need to restrict access to anyone who has not done so.
- All table bookings are reserved for a maximum of 1 ½ hours.
- The maximum group size for a booking is 6 persons, including children of any age.
- All members of a group dining inside need to be living together or share a support bubble.
- We serve alcoholic drinks only to guests who consume a starter and/or a main meal from our menu.
- Please let us know whether you bring special items like prams, wheelchairs etc.
- All guests are always required to wear face coverings, except when seated at the table.
- We encourage you to use the hand sanitisers that have been provided by us.
- Please do not move any furniture, inside as well as outside.
- We operate table service only, i.e. there will be no ordering at the bar. Payment at the bar is still possible at the 2 designated payment points, which can be identified by the Perspex screens.
- It is not permitted to drink and/or eat at the bar.
- Please stay seated at your table while eating and/or drinking.
- Please do not wander around the restaurant area.
- Children are always to be seated at the table.
- Please leave your used glasses and/or plates at the designated tables and we will collect them for you.
- We have a one-way system in operation, so you are kindly encouraged to follow the arrows.
- Our toilets are accessible for one person at the time. Look at the traffic lights for the gents and ladies, which should tell you whether the toilet area is in use.
- The Greyhound Inn will close every day at 22:30 latest, which means we encourage guests to start leaving the premises at 22:15.
