

GDPR Privacy Policy Notice

This GDPR Privacy Policy has been compiled to better serve those who are concerned with how their 'Personally Identifiable Information' (PII) is being used online. PII, as described in EU & UK privacy GDPR law and information security, is information that can be used on its own or with other information to identify, contact, or locate a single person, or to identify an individual in context. Please read our Privacy Policy carefully to get a clear understanding of how we collect, use, protect or otherwise handle your Personally Identifiable Information (PII) in accordance with our website.

What personal information do we collect from the people that visit our website or app?

When ordering or registering on our site, as appropriate, you may be asked to enter your name and email address. We will not collect any personal data that we do not need.

When do we collect information?

We collect information from you when you place an order or enter information on our site, or enrol in the Online Programs, via an Application Form or Order Form. ***We will NEVER share your information with anyone.***

How do we use your information?

We may use the information we collect from you when you register, make a purchase, sign up for our newsletter, respond to a survey or marketing communication, surf the website, or use certain other site features in the following ways:

- To personalise your experience and to allow us to deliver the type of content, product offerings and services in which you are most interested.
- To allow us to better service you in responding to your customer service requests and guidance to the best lifestyle choices.

How do we protect your information?

Our website is scanned on a regular basis for security holes and known vulnerabilities in order to make your visit to our site as safe as possible. We use regular Malware Scanning.

Your personal information is contained behind secured networks and is only accessible by a limited number of persons who have special access rights to such systems, and are required to keep the information confidential. In addition, all sensitive/credit information you supply is encrypted via Secure Socket Layer (SSL) technology.

We implement a variety of security measures when a user places an order enters, submits, or accesses their information to maintain the safety of your personal information.

All transactions are processed through a payment gateway provider and are not stored or processed on our servers.

How long do we keep your Data?

We are required under UK tax law and insurance to keep your basic personal data (name, address, contact details, consultation forms and Questionnaires) for a minimum of 10 years after which time it will be destroyed.

Do we use 'cookies'?

We do NOT use cookies for tracking purposes.
