## TOEIC Semi-intensive Course, 22, 25 or 30 lessons:

## Preparing for the TOEIC Exam at Horner School of English

The TOEIC examination focuses on everyday language skills which are frequently used in the workplace, school or everyday social situations. The course starts with a step-by-step breakdown of the format of the exam and the skills, functions, and topics to be tested, before moving on to more targeted language work. Tuition includes vocabulary building, basic grammatical and functional work as well as completing sample exam questions and exam practice. Your teacher will design your lessons to focus on your strengths and weaknesses as they relate to the exam.

### For B2 learners, the focus of listening tuition will be to ensure that they can:

- Understand standard spoken English delivered at normal speed.
- Follow short conversations both formal and informal in a range of familiar situations understanding gist, context, purpose, function, attitude, feelings, opinions, and relationships.
- Extract and reproduce key information from announcements, media broadcasts, presentations and lectures including abstract and concrete topics encountered in personal, social, academic, and vocational life.
- Follow clearly structured extended speech and more complex argument when familiar with the topic.
- Recognise feelings, moods, attitudes, important points, and opinions expressed through stress, pitch, and intonation.

### For B2 learners, the focus of the reading tuition will be to ensure that they can:

- Understand texts in different styles and purposes with a large degree of independence.
- Understand the main ideas in complex texts on both familiar and abstract topics.
- Locate specific information from different parts of a text.
- Understand a broad range of vocabulary but may experience some difficulty with low frequency idioms.
- Understand texts which contain a broad range of grammatical structures.

### Everyday Functional English is tested thoroughly in the exam in the following contexts:

- Talking about your environment.
- Expressing thoughts, feelings, and attitudes.
- Using language to report on and describe different social & work-related instructions, tasks and situations.
- Language of social contact.

### Vocabulary and grammar are consolidated and expanded on a variety of appropriate topics such as:

- Daily life, travel, health, education, technology.
