

## **SSV TRAVEL GRANTS FOR GRADUATE STUDENTS & POST DOCS**

Applications for travel grants from SSV are accepted on a rolling schedule. Applicants must be registered graduate students or junior post docs (<5years). These are primarily for active conference participation with oral presentations of research in the field of virology. Members of SSV normally have priority for travel grants. Membership is acquired through participation in the annual Smögen Summer Symposium on Virology and is valid for three consecutive years following meeting participation. Decisions on grants are normally taken at board meetings in January, April, August and October. Each award amounts to a maximum of 4.000Skr.
