

IAPS Sports Booking Terms and Conditions

1. All staff or adults who are responsible for the care and wellbeing of children at IAPS events must be fully compliant with [Keeping Children Safe in Education 2018](#) and have undertaken the appropriate checks. It is the schools responsibility to ensure compliance.
2. Contests held in the name of IAPS are open only to pupils of schools whose Heads are members of the Association.
3. Children at senior schools linked to IAPS junior schools are not eligible for entry. Only the pupils in the age range registered with IAPS as forming part of the prep school may be entered.
4. The person making the booking is responsible for ensuring their school is a member of IAPS.
5. If your school is found not to be a member of IAPS, your entry will automatically be withdrawn from the event. A decision to refund all or part of the entry fee charged will be at the sole discretion of IAPS.
6. The person making the booking is responsible for ensuring their Headteacher has given authorisation to enter the event.
7. IAPS regrets that it cannot accept liability for loss or damage however caused to the personal property of any person attending this or any other event organised under the auspices of the Association.
8. The person making the booking is responsible for ensuring that your school has the necessary insurance in place to cover your school attending and participating in this event.
9. Refunds - If you cancel your booking up to and including 4 weeks prior to the date a full refund will be given. Thereafter IAPS regrets that no refund can be made. Refunds can only be given when requested in writing via email to sport@iaps.uk
