

DATA PROTECTION 1.0



The Data Protection module sets out essential knowledge relating to data protection concepts and principles, data subject rights, the implementation of data protection policies and measures, and regulatory compliance.

Increasingly large flows of data are changing our economy and society, transforming existing services and ways of work and promoting innovative problem solving. Organisations can, for example, better tailor products to individuals and can understand and better predict what groups of people may demand, and how they may behave. But with all this transformation, it is more important than ever that the people working with often sensitive personal data have the skills to do so securely and legally. The personal consequences for individuals of a breach of the security of their personal data can be

substantial, as can be the legal and commercial consequences for organisations.

The General Data Protection Regulation, an EU law on protecting data, sets out firm rules for how personal data must be processed, and gives individuals strong rights regarding how their information is used and by whom.

Skills for data protection are needed for increasing numbers of workers—ICDL Data Protection delivers these skills.
