Materials

Carcass: 16mm MFC

- Fixing point dimensions are for guidance only/the positions of wall fixing must be checked when product is received.
- Legs provide height adjustment range of 75mm (included in the box, but not shown in the diagram).
- Care should be taken when calculating configurations without filler/end panels.

A: It is highly recommended to secure it to the wall drilling through the back brace. There are adjustable wall hangers installed in the unit and a wall hanging kit is provided.

A: No, these will need to be ordered separately - see brochure for reference.

A. 16mm MFC, held in position with shelf pins. Shelves are adjustable at a 98mm height increment.

A: Use the adjustment screw on the rear of the wall hanging mechanism to make vertical adjustments.

A: Follow instructions (provided upon request). Ensure adjustable leg is orientated correctly, plinth is in-line with front face of door fascia & plinth clips are used to step-off sufficiently.
