

Scholarship Terms and Conditions

Scholarships

Ironhack is one of the top-ranked Tech Schools offering 9-weeks of intensive and immersive courses in Web Development, UX/UI Design and Data Analytics and with campuses located in Madrid, Barcelona, Miami, Paris, Mexico City, Berlin, Amsterdam, São Paulo and Lisbon. Since 2013, Ironhack has graduated over 3000 students who are building their careers at companies like Google, Magic Leap, and Twitter.

Facebook has selected Ironhack as its partner for the 2019 Facebook F8 Scholarship: The Digital Creators Fund, an up to \$250,000 scholarship program, based on the number of qualified applicants, for women and minorities in the tech industry. Full and partial scholarships with a value of up to \$12,000 will be offered to qualifying individuals who want to study web development at Ironhack's Miami campus (each, an "Applicant"). Ironhack has additionally pledged up to \$125,000, based on the number of qualified applicants, for full and partial Ironhack Scholarships for other qualified individuals who will make an impact and want to study web development, data analytics, and UX/UI design at Ironhack Miami's campus. Both the Digital Creators Fund scholarship and Ironhack scholarships together, shall be referred to in these Terms and Conditions as the "Scholarship(s)."

Ironhack and not Facebook is solely responsible for evaluating and making Scholarship award determinations. It is understood that a limited number of full scholarships will be awarded, in addition to partial scholarships of varying amounts. By applying for the Scholarships described herein, you agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. Ironhack is not responsible for the policies, regulations, laws, actions, or inactions of others that might prevent you from applying for or participating in the Scholarships, and/or claiming the scholarship if it is awarded. Application for these scholarships constitutes Applicant's full and unconditional agreement to Ironhack 's decisions in administering the scholarship program, which are final and binding in all matters related thereto.

Scholarship Application Period

Registrants must apply for Scholarships between April 30, 2019 and May 10, 2019 for the summer session (starting in June), and May 31, 2019 for the fall sessions(August or October) ("Application Period"). Award of Scholarships shall happen on a periodically rolling basis and notification of awards will be sent to winners before May 21st for summer session and before June 18th for the fall session.

Eligibility

The scholarship awards are only open to individuals who are:

- At the time of application are at least 18 years of age on the date of entry; and
- A legal resident of the United States.
- For the Digital Creators Fund Scholarship, a woman or racial minority.
- This Scholarship offer is void wherever restricted or prohibited by law.
- Applicant's rights and responsibilities may vary by jurisdiction.

How to Apply

At any time during the Application Period, access the Scholarship application from <https://ironhack.typeform.com/to/Qtih8w> and complete the application in full prior to the end of the Application Period. The Applicant will then be provided further information about completing the technical evaluations and any subsequent interviews.

Award of Scholarships

Judging Criteria:

The scholarships will be awarded by Ironhack in its sole discretion, based on its analysis of:

- Satisfactory completion of the application.
- The content of applications, evaluated based on the quality and thoughtfulness of responses.
- Sufficient prerequisite knowledge necessary for the programs, as demonstrated by the application, technical evaluation and personal interviews.
- Satisfactory completion of the technical skills evaluation for the desired course of study.
- A demonstrated desire to participate in the training and use of that training to make a positive impact.

The decisions of Ironhack are final, binding, and not subject to appeal. Ironhack reserves the right to not award all scholarships in its sole discretion if it does not receive a sufficient number of qualified Applicants, or otherwise for reasons of force-majeure or causes beyond Ironhack's reasonable control. Ironhack also reserves the right to change the Terms and Conditions of this contest upon reasonable notice to the Applicants.

Announcement of Scholarship Awards:

Winners will be individually contacted by Ironhack and/or its representatives via e-mail addresses and contact numbers provided during application for the Scholarships by no later than June 18th. Facebook and/or Ironhack may also announce scholarship awards publicly. Scholarship awards are non-transferrable. Awards must be claimed by registering for a class no later than May 24th for the summer session and June 24th for the fall session.

Privacy Notice

Applicants agree that Ironhack may collect, store, share and otherwise use information provided during the registration/application process, including, but not limited to, full name, mailing address, phone number, and email address, including for administering the Scholarship program and verifying the

Applicants identity, postal address, telephone number, eligibility, self-identified race/ethnicity/gender, job title, and LinkedIn profile URL (if available) in the event an Applicant is selected for a Scholarship. This information shall be compiled by Ironhack to create an impact report.

By applying and participating in this Scholarship program, each Applicant agrees that if the Applicant is awarded a Scholarship, Applicant's full name may be announced publicly (for example it may be posted on the Scholarship's website(s)) and his or her name and image may be used to promote the Scholarship program.

Governing Law

The scholarship program is governed by the laws of the State of Florida, excluding its conflict-of-laws principles. The exclusive venue for any dispute relating to this scholarship program shall be Miami-Dade County, Florida.

General Liability Release/Force Majeure

Applicants agree that Ironhack shall not be responsible or liable for any losses, damages or injuries of any kind resulting from application for the Scholarship programs or any program-related activity. Ironhack reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who is found to be tampering with the Scholarship award process, or to be acting in a disruptive manner, or with the intent to disrupt or undermine the legitimate operation of the program, or to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass any other person, and Ironhack reserves the right to seek damages and other remedies from any such person to the fullest extent permitted by law.
