Method of Sale

The property is offered for sale by private treaty as a whole. It is likely that any sale will be concluded by asking for Sealed Bids.

Planning

The land is classified as being in the Rural Area. As such, there is a general presumption against most forms of development although some agricultural or small-scale equestrian development should be possible (please seek independent advice regarding this).

Overage Provision

The Seller will retain an overage for 25 years for 25% of any enhanced value following the grant of planning permission and/or disposal for an alternate use than that currently existing, save agricultural and small-scale equestrian change of use, the latter being defined as a change of use that would not enhance the existing use value by more than £100,000.

Tenure and Possession

The Freehold of the land is available with Vacant Possession. The land is currently unregistered, so the buyer will need to register on completion of the purchase.

Central Bedfordshire Council.

Easements, Covenants and Rights of Way

The property is sold subject to all existing wayleaves, easements, public or private rights of way, covenants and restrictions, whether stated in these particulars or not. A footpath passes over the land.

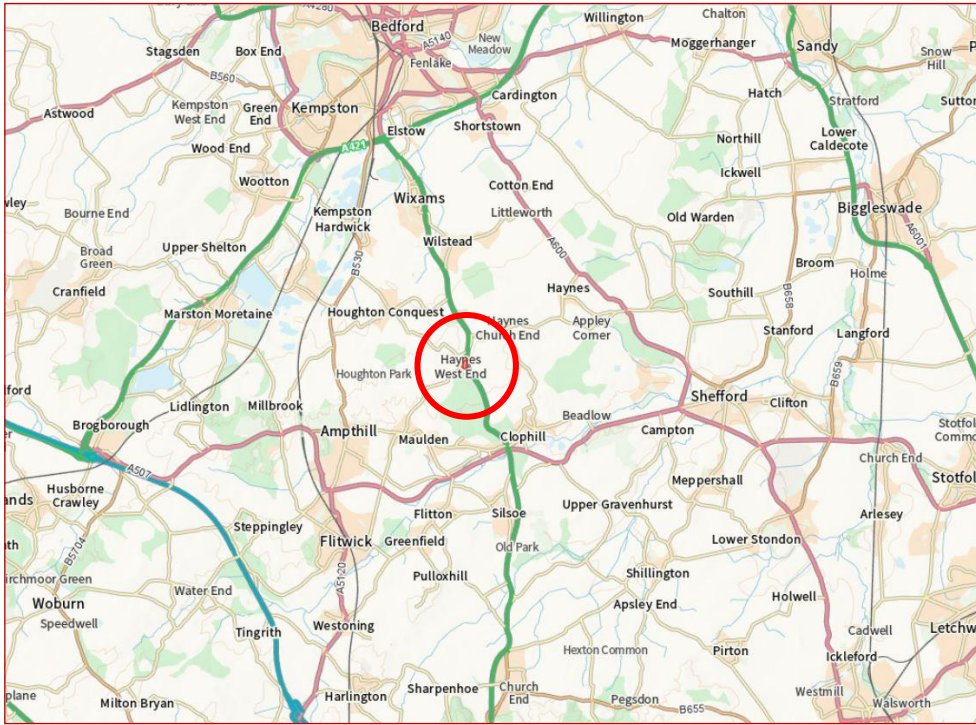
Viewing

When making any inspection, for safety reasons, please be mindful of the undulating nature of the land.

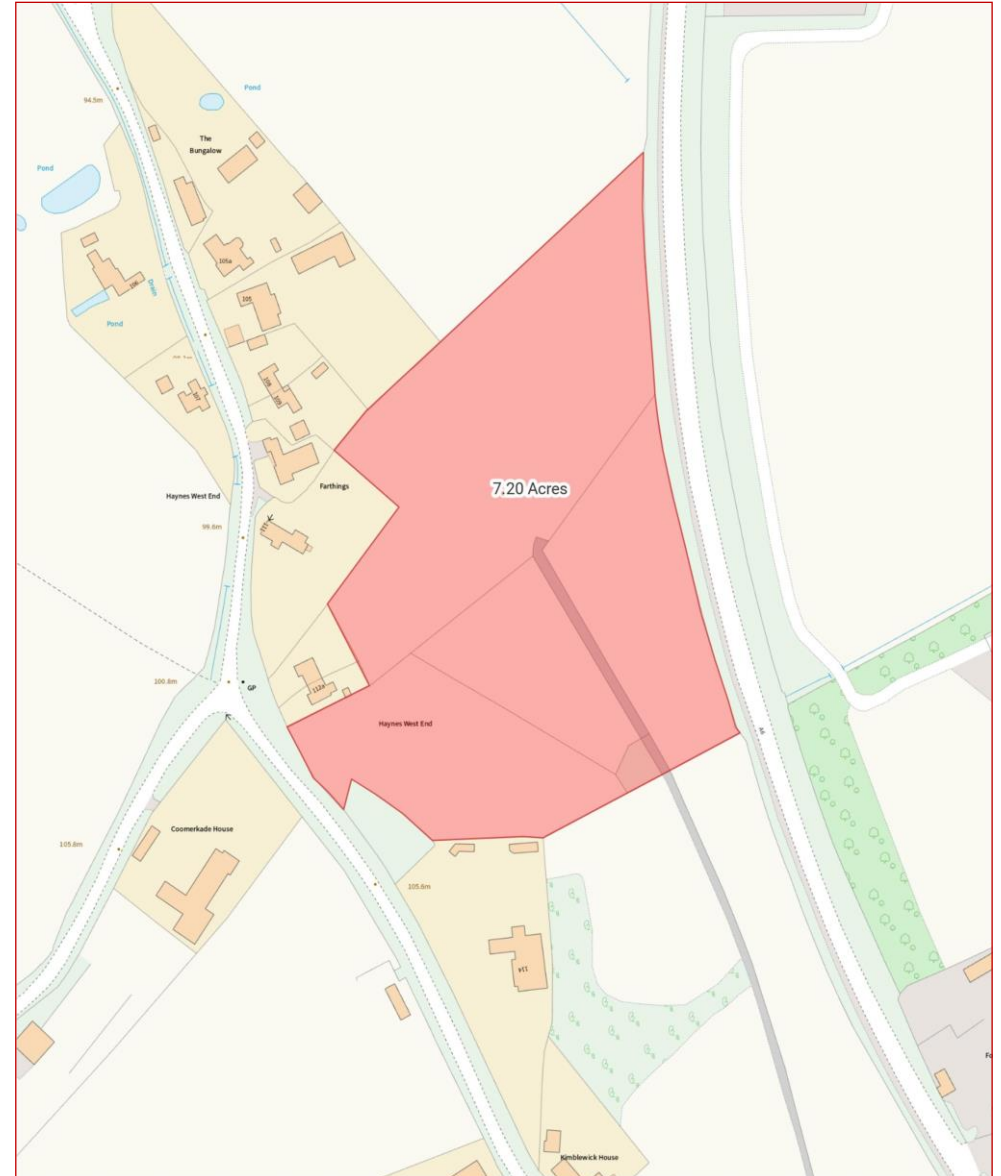
