Description

This two bedroom lower cottage flat sits on an elevated position and enjoys it's own private front & back door and garden space. Although requiring some modernisation this property offers superb potential and enjoys a central setting just a short distance from a host of local amenities.

A few steps from pavement level lead to a shared pathway which runs along the side of the building. This property has a private front garden mainly laid in lawn with monoblock paving leading to the entrance door.

Inside a long reception hall welcomes you in and links to all the principal rooms. There are two nicely proportioned bedrooms, the larger bedroom one is to the front whilst bedroom two is to the rear. Both bedrooms have handy enclosed storage space. The lounge is another well proportioned room offering a great space to relax and entertain within. The focal point of this room is a fireplace with gas fire. A broad window formation to the front elevation lends plenty of natural light. Mention should be made of the pleasant aspects over the front garden and beyond.

A doorway to the rear of the lounge leads to the modern fitted kitchen which comes complete with integrated gas hob and electric oven. The washing machine is also included in the sale. A deep cupboard provides extra storage space and the gas fired combination boiler is housed here. Two window formations lend light and a door provides direct access to the rear garden.

The bathroom completes the accommodation on offer and is fitted with a three piece suite and shower attachment to the bath. The walls are tiled and there is a window formation to the rear.

The windows have been replaced with PVC framed double glazed units. External doors to the front and rear are formed in PVC with double glazed panels. There is a gas fired central heating system with Potterton combination boiler.

As noted there is a private front garden with lawn, monoblock paving and a terraced decking area. To the rear this property has a patio area immediately adjacent to the building and a decking area to the far rear with a shared drying green in the middle.

643 Carntyne Road enjoys a popular setting within the Carntyne district lying to the east of Glasgow. There are convenient local shops and amenities just round the corner on Carntynehall Road & Edinburgh Road including a Post Office, Chemist and Doctors Surgery. Further shopping & recreational facilities are available at the nearby Forge Shopping Centre and also at the Glasgow Fort Retail Park. Those commuting have excellent road links to Glasgow City Centre and to the M8 and M74 Motorway networks. There are regular bus services operating in the area and Carntyne Train Station is just a short walk away. Furthermore there is highly regarded schooling available at both Primary and Secondary level within the immediate and surrounding areas.

This property is of non-traditional "Winget" construction and as such is not considered suitable security for mortgage lending purposes. Hence offers are invited from cash buyers only.

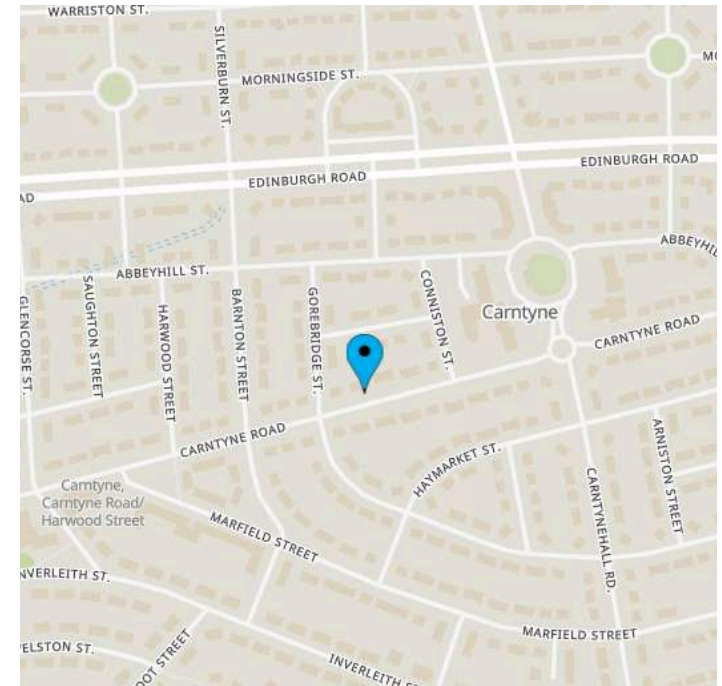
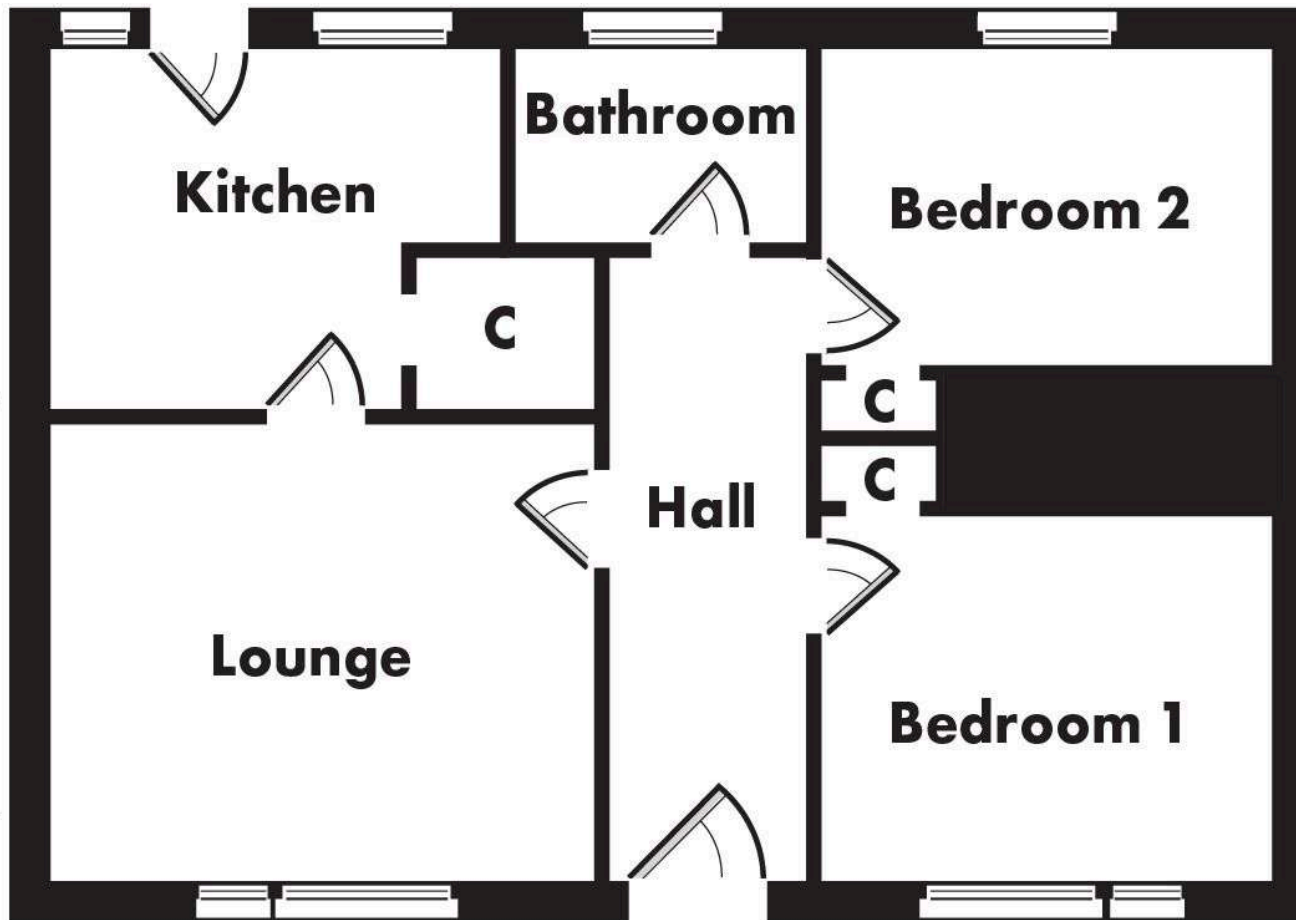
