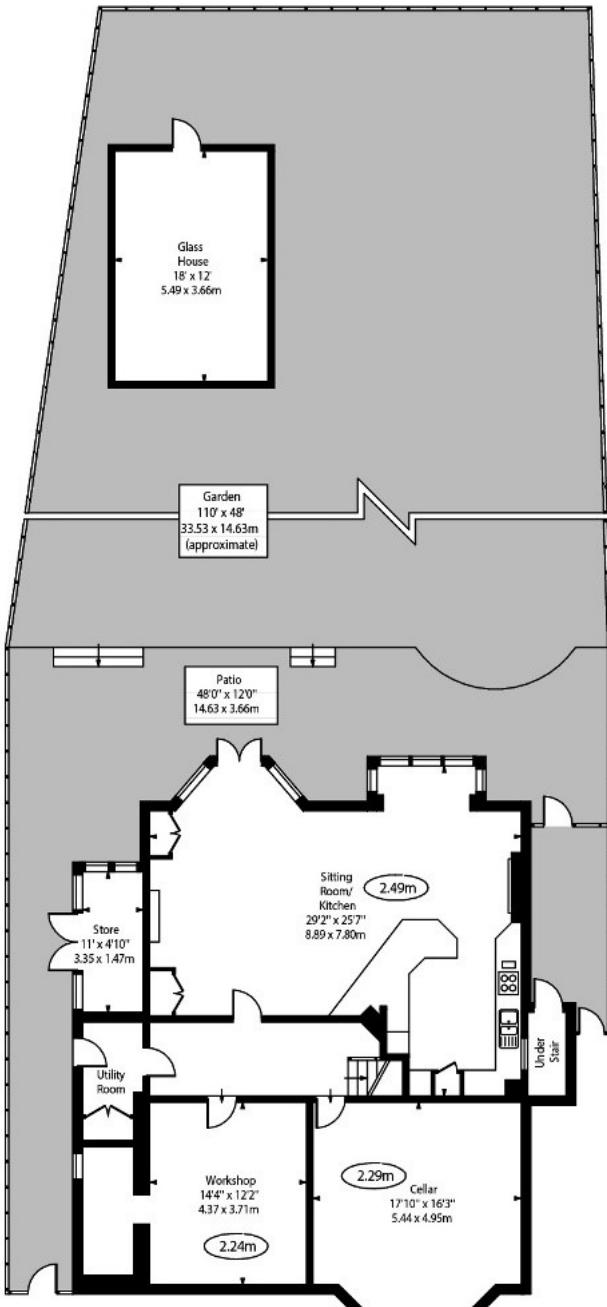




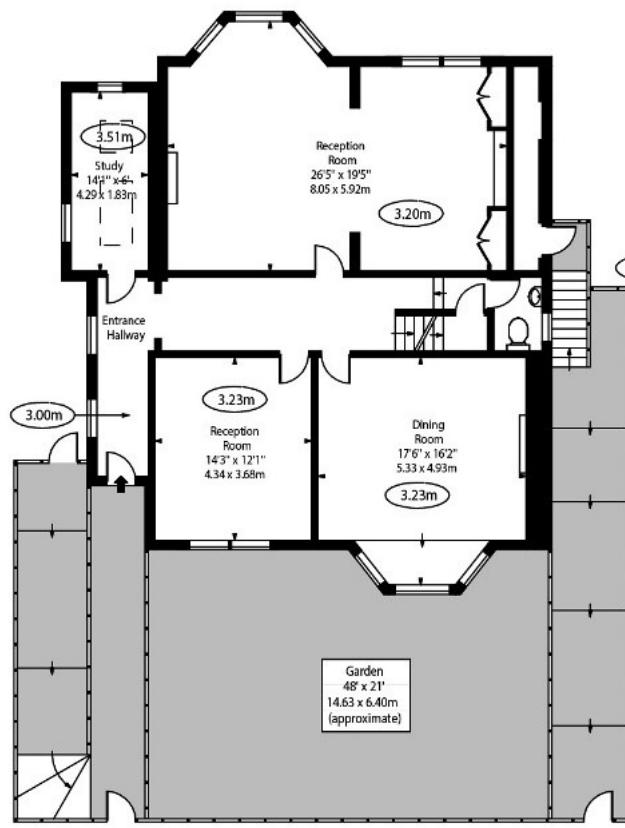




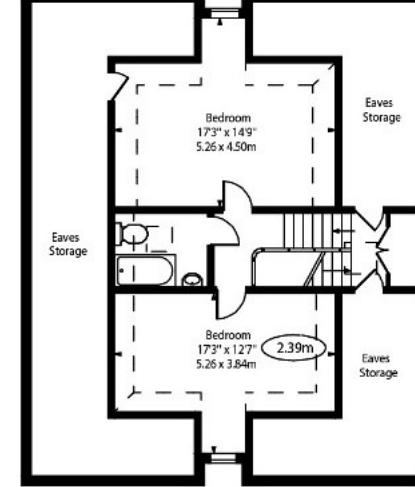




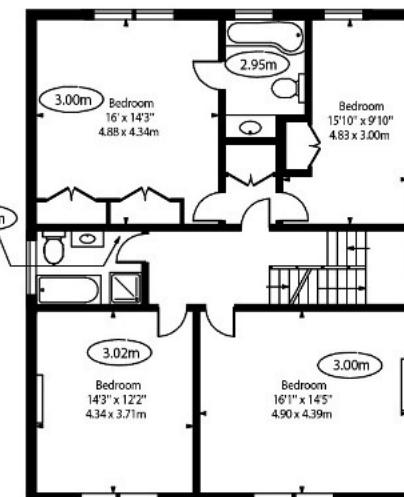
Lower Ground Floor
