GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Cowgill Barn comprises a traditional stone barn located in the centre of the village of Thornton in Craven. The property benefits from full planning permission to create a four bedroomed house.

The village of Thornton in Craven is in the Craven District and has limited local facilities including a church, a primary school and a retirement home, and the Pennine Way passes through the village.

PLANNING

Planning approval was granted on 30 November 2021 (Decision No. 2021/23366/FUL refers) for the conversion of the barn and shippon to create a single residential unit with the imaginative design by renowned local Architect, John Wharton.

The approved scheme provides four bedroomed accommodation over two floors together with a garage and private courtyard garden area.

TENURE

The property will be sold freehold with vacant possession upon completion.

SERVICES

Mains electricity and water are connected to the barn and there is a nearby mains drainage connection. Purchasers should make their own enquiries as to the services available.

The property is sold subject to all wayleaves, easements and rights of way, both public and private, which may affect the sale.

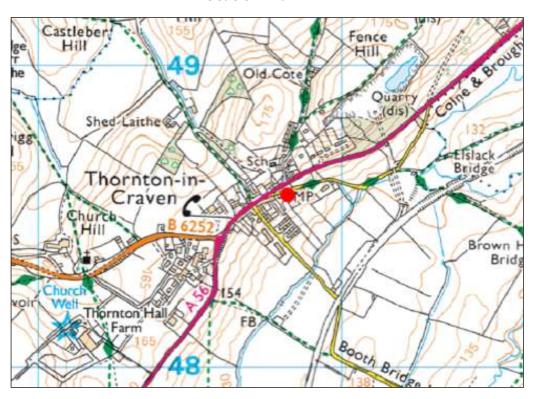
DIRECTIONS

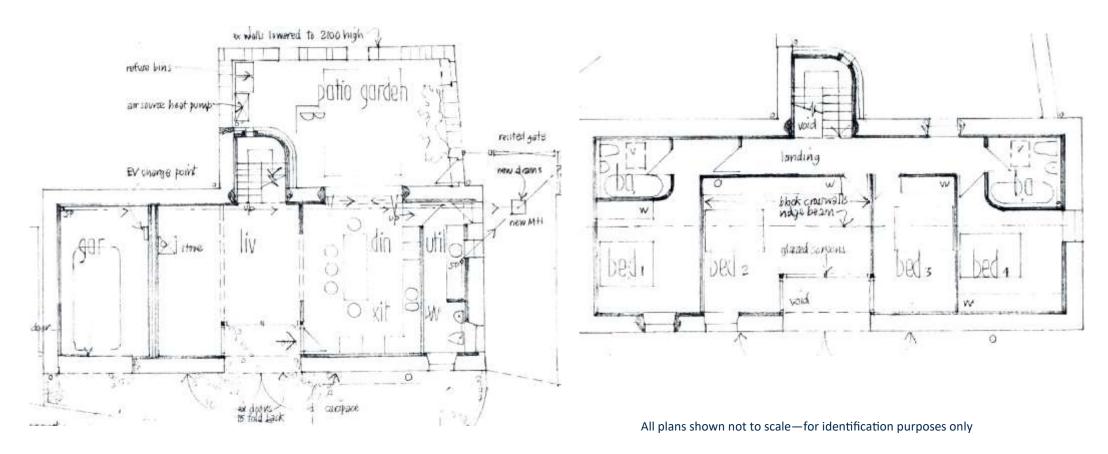


Location Plan
