The Property

The property offered for sale is a spacious detached four bedroom house situated in a pleasant location in the grounds of The Pheasant Hotel 'twixt the villages of Kelling and Weybourne. The property enjoys open views to the front aspect over the surrounding countryside and to the sea beyond. Adjacent to The Lodge is Muckleburgh Hill which gives easy access to wonderful coastal and country walks. The well presented accommodation briefly comprises: a covered entrance porch, entrance hall, good size living room. A well fitted out kitchen, double aspect sitting room with a woodburner style gas fire and views to the sea. Rear hall and cloakroom. On the first floor a spacious landing leads to a master bedroom with en-suite, three further double bedrooms and a family bathroom. The property also enjoys the benefit of oil fired central heating and replacement UPVC sealed unit double glazed windows and doors. Outside, there is ample off street parking, and a double garage. There are gardens to the front of the house and a very private enclosed rear garden. The property is being sold with no onward chain.

Location

Kelling lies within a designated area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and is a small attractive residential village. Interestingly it has a reputation for past smuggling. The village contains a popular and thriving village school, a reading room which is now a bookshop, gallery and tea rooms and a pebble beach. The Lodge is adjacent to Muckleborough Hill with 21 hectares of heathland leading to the coastal path and sea. One mile to the east of the village is the village of Weybourne which has a greater range of amenities and a few miles away to the west is the village of Cley-next-the-sea with its world renowned National Trust marshes and excellent bird-watching facilities. Slightly further on are the villages of Blakeney and Morston where wonderful sailing facilities will be found. Two miles inland is the exceptionally picturesque Georgian town of Holt offering an extensive range of shops and businesses where a friendly and personal service still remains. The town is also home to Gresham's Public School. The county city of Norwich is 20 miles away with fast rail links to London, Liverpool Street. Norwich airport has direct flights to most international destinations via Schipol.

Directions

Leave Holt town centre via the Cromer Road. Upon passing Gresham's Preparatory School on your right hand side take the first turning left into the Kelling Road. Follow this road for around one mile before turning left where signposted Kelling. Continue on this road for around one mile whereupon you will enter the village. Proceed through the village, at the T junction with the coast road turn right and the property will be found after a short distance on your right hand side identified by a Pointens for sale board.

The property is approached over a gravelled driveway providing ample off street parking. This in turn leads to an attached double garage (21'4 x 19') with electric roller doors, electric power and light, washing machine, fitted worktop and shelving. Door to inner hall and door to rear garden. To the front of the house is a lawned garden with inset flower and shrub beds. A pathway leads to the rear of the property where there is a private enclosed rear garden, laid mainly to lawn. There is also a patio area directly behind the house, a modern plastic oil tank, a wooden garden shed, various inset flower and shrub beds and a pergola. There is an outside oil fired boiler for central heating and domestic hot water.


