

How to Enrol

Three Term Diploma, Two Term Diploma, Foundation Certificate

The first step is to book an informal interview by contacting Reception on 020 8749 6400, or registrar@leiths.com. You can contact us Monday to Friday, 9.00am – 5.00pm. You can now also request a 1:1 chat at www.leiths.com/virtual-open-day-2020

Interviews are offered during the week, during office hours generally between 9.30am – 3.00pm.

Due to the current situation we are currently offering interviews by phone and video. Your interview will be hosted by either our Managing Director, School Principal or a senior teacher. You'll have an opportunity to talk about yourself, what you are hoping to achieve and we can discuss our courses and their suitability for you. We can of course talk you through our current social distancing and health and safety policies and explain what to expect in the new academic year as well as answer any questions that you may have. It is important that you inform us in your interview if you have any relevant medical conditions and/or specific learning difficulties that could affect your time on the course. You should allow up to half an hour for the appointment.

Whilst we are not able to welcome you to view the school right now we are delighted to present our new online open day, where you can take a virtual tour the school, watch a sample demonstration with head teacher Michael Cropp, and hear from the students and alumni about life at Leiths School of Food & Wine. Things you need to check in advance

You must ensure that you have been vaccinated for tetanus.

It is of great importance that you give us all relevant information to be able to teach and support you during your course or the School may terminate its contract with you.

If English is your second language you should have proof that you've attained an IELTS (International English Language Testing System) band score of 6.5 which equates to C1 on the CEFR (Council of Europe's Common European Framework). If you have studied at degree level before in the UK this will not be needed.
