Situation and Description

A beautifully presented terraced house which has been greatly improved in recent years. The property benefits from uPVC double glazing, gas central heating, neutral décor and lovely views to the front and rear from the first floor.

The property offers accommodation comprising entrance hall, full depth sitting room, superb kitchen/diner with recently fitted units, conservatory, two double bedrooms, one large single bedroom, bathroom and separate W.C.

Outside

Front

Small, predominately lawned garden and path to front door.

Rear

Well maintained, lawned garden with paved patio seating area and path leading to gated access to the rear. The garden is well enclosed, private and enjoys a southerly aspect.

Parking

There is unrestricted on road parking.

Corsham Road lies on the outskirts of The National Trust village of Lacock which dates back to the 13th-century and remains largely unchanged over the centuries with its many limewashed, half-timbered and stone houses. Bowden Hill itself offers two public houses and the village has four further public houses, a church and a shop/post office. A wider range of facilities can be found in the nearby town of Chippenham which offers supermarkets, a sports centre and a public library together with a mainline railway station (London-Paddington). There is good access to major motor commuting routes including the M4 motorway at Junction 17.

Turn left from the end of the High Street onto Pickwick Road and at the mini roundabout take the first exit onto Lacock Road. Proceed over the railway bridge and bear left onto Corsham Road. Turn right just before the post box and bus stop and at the T-junction turn left and the property can be found almost immediately on the right hand side.
