The inner hallway/boot room has a door to the garden and a door to the cloakroom. The hallway leads through to the kitchen, this has a generous range of wall and base units, with working surfaces over.

At first floor level the landing leads to three good size bedrooms and the family bathroom, with a separate shower

over the bath.

Outside, to the side of the property there is off-road parking, pedestrian access leads to the rear garden, that is well-enclosed and offers a good degree of privacy. It is predominantly laid to lawn with flower and shrub borders and a patio area, offering a place to sit and relax.

Amenities

The market town of Cirencester is often referred to as the 'Capital of the Cotswolds'. It is ideally located with the M4, M5 and M40/A40, the mainline train station at Kemble and excellent bus and coach links all within easy reach.

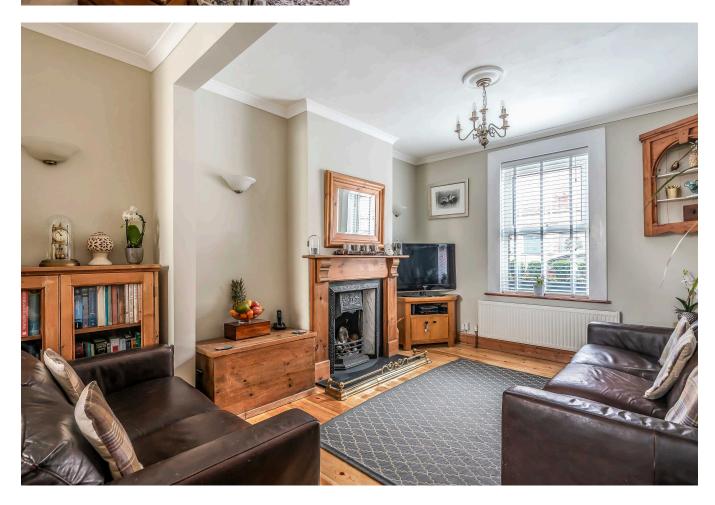

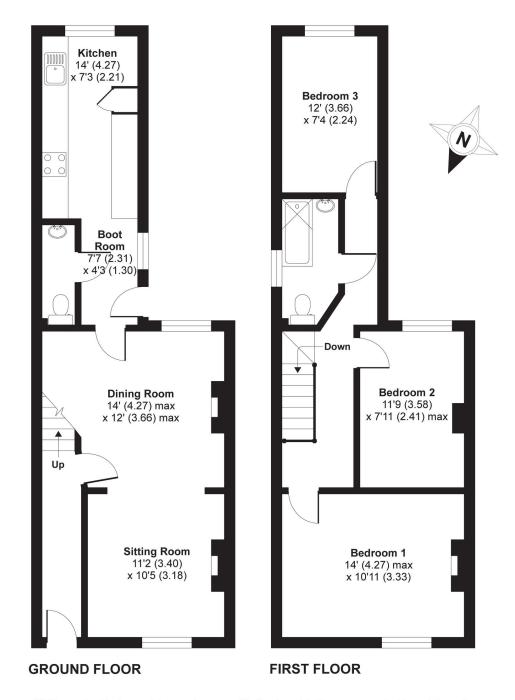
