

PORT OF ALGECIRAS STATEMENT DUE TO COVID – 19

25TH MARCH, 2020

On 14th March, the Spanish Government issued the “State of Alarm” across the country under the Decree 463/2020, this mechanism aims to curb the spread of corona virus.

The Port Authority of Algeciras is implementing all measures announced by central government to prevent the further spread of the corona virus.

Please be advised on the following:

- Accesses to the Port of Algeciras are open.
- Both container terminals APMT Algeciras and TTI-Algeciras are under regular operation.
- Roro Traffic for Goods:
 - Both maritime connection with the ports of Ceuta and TangerMed are fully operational. Please be advised that passenger traffic with TangerMed is not permitted until further announcement.
 - Traffic between Tarifa Port and Tangerville Port is suspended.
 - Roro parking within the Port facilities is on service.
- The Boarder Inspection Point (PIF) is fully operational.
- Ships calls: All incoming ships must submit, as usual, the **Maritime Declaration of Health** (MDH) 24 hours before calling at port, in which the ship's master must declare whether there is any illness or suspected illness on board, together with a list of the last ten ports called at.

The Port of Algeciras is considered a strategic infrastructure for the Spanish supply chain integrated in the international logistic network. Hence, the Port of Algeciras along with the collaboration of its Port Community will overcome all together successfully this worldwide sanitary emergency, undertaking further efforts actively if required.
