# √ General description:

**FTL128** is a rigid moulded product. It is light brown in colour and contains a proportion of brass chipping to enhance its heat dissipation properties. This is a non-asbestos material, based on a blend of synthetic fibres with a specially developed resin binder.

**FTL128** combines a medium friction coefficient with good resistance to fade and a low rate of wear. It machines well and discs can readily be gear cut for use in multiplate clutches.

This material is suitable for use either dry or in oil immersed application.

Clutches for marine gearboxes Steering clutches. Clutches for machine tools, presses and other industrial plant and machinery.

## ✓ Bonding:

**FTL128** may be bonded using any of the established adhesives recommended for friction material. However, to obtain the best results it is necessary to use a thermosetting adhesive.

## ✓ Mating Surface

A good quality, fine grained, pearlitic cast iron or cold rolled steel with a Brinell hardness of 200. Cast steels are not recommended
