

MAINTENANCE LIST 5056

The following is not an exhaustive list. For illustrative purposes only, we hereby notify that the unit requires the following maintenance:

- Hull (Top side): matted and degraded. Needs polishing. Main deck sidescuttles to be restored.
- Hull (lower side) and appendices: needs matt sanding due to detachment of gelcoat from the bottom of anchoring area. Flap, rudder axis pads, solidity of the connection of the propeller to the hull need checking and zinc anodes must be replaced.
- Restoration axis and propellers (helixes are missing)
- Bushings replacement: axle stands and cases bushes are degraded
- Steel opacification and oxidation: washing and polishing
- Deck teak restoration
- Gunwale degraded needs painting
- Planking of main deck watertight doors needs restoration and upper deck sliding doors slide rails need shaping and grouting
- Restoration of window and upper deck main door watertightness: window seals next to watertight doors in main deck and upper deck main door are degraded and show infiltrations. Seals must be replaced.
- Replacement of watertight door
- Stern external jetway needs restoration, duckboard must be replaced and the steel boom must be restored due to deformation and eventually must be polished.
- Upper deck well scupper system needs restoration
- Main deck well electric system needs restoration
- Towing crane check
- Antenna and floodlights dismantled
- Check and maintenance of bow and stern mooring winches
- External furniture degraded: wooden furniture located in the external area is degraded by exposure to weather conditions
- Duckboard restoration: due to severe degradation replacement of all duckboards
- Ceiling electric wiring restoration
- Wooden surface restoration: all wooden surfaces are degraded and need restoration of all elements, deep matt sanding, cleaning, degreasing and owners new top coating
- Toilet marbles damaged
- Living room and kitchen floor degraded and wallpapers need cleaning and disinfection
- Carpet replacement
- MM.PP ordinary and extraordinary maintenance – complete system check
- Ordinary and extraordinary maintenance of reducers/inverters
- Ordinary and extraordinary maintenance of generators
- Small parts and steel parts oxidation in engine room and technical room
- Intakes and outlets check
- Tank restoration and disinfection (fuel, clear and black waters)
- Bilges restoration and revision

- Complete electric check
- Battery charger replacement
- MM.PP battery replacement (battery exhausted)
- Services battery replacement (battery exhausted)
- Generator batteries replacement (batteries exhausted)
- Black and grey waters drain pumps supply and assembly
- Boiler supply and assembly and removal of old boiler
- Services pump supply and assembly
- Bilge and firefighting pumps in engine room revision
- Air conditioning revision and restoration
- Fresh water circuit check and maintenance
- Engine room firefighting system revision
- Automation system and video surveillance system restoration
- Stabilizer check
- Navigation equipment check
- Appliances check and supply
- Safety installations renewal and/or restoration
- Supply of chain and anchor
- Stern mirror steel letters restoration
