## National Curriculum Objectives

Pupils should be taught to:

- ❖ Know about the work of artists craft-makers and designers
- ❖ Describe the differences and similarities between different practices and disciplines

## Knowledge

- ❖ To know the different styles used by a range of artists. (Van Gogh and Monet)
- ❖ To be able to describe the work of different artists making.
- ❖ To be able to describe similarities and differences between the works of artists covered.
- ❖ To know how to use an artists work to inspire and recreate their own.



## Skills

- ❖ Explore the differences and similarities within the work of artists, craftspeople and designers in different times and cultures.
- ❖ Ask and answer questions about the starting points for their work and the processes they have used. Develop their ideas.
- ❖ Review what they and others have done and say what they think and feel about it. E.g. Annotate sketchbook
- ❖ Identify what they might change in their current work or develop in their future work.
- ❖ Investigate different kinds of art, craft and design.
