#### **National Curriculum Objectives**

Pupils should be taught to:

- Know about the work of artists craft-makers and designers
- Describe the differences and similarities between different practices and disciplines

### **Knowledge**

- ❖ To know the different styles used by a range of artists. (Van Gogh and Monet)
- To be able to describe the work of different artists making.
- To be able to describe similarities and differences between the works of artists covered.
- To know how to use an artists work to inspire and recreate their own.



#### Skills

- Explore the differences and similarities within the work of artists, craftspeople and designers in different times and cultures.
- Ask and answer questions about the starting points for their work and the processes they have used. Develop their ideas.
- Review what they and others have done and say what they think and feel about it. E.g. Annotate sketchbook
- Identify what they might change in their current work or develop in their future work.
- Investigate different kinds of art, craft and design.
