National Curriculum Objectives

Pupils should be taught to:

❖ To sculpt creatively with a range of materials to improve their art and design.

- Know how to adapt their work and make improvements.

- Show an understanding of shape, space and form.
- Plan, design, make and adapt models.
- Talk about their work understanding that it has been sculpted, modelled or constructed. Use a variety of materials.
- Work on their own, and collaboratively with others, on projects in 2 and 3 dimensions and on different scales.
- Adapt their work according to their views and describe how they might develop it further.
