When and where did they live?

Hull  
Born on 24th August 1759  
Died on 29th July 1833

London, England  
Born on 24th May 1819  
Died on 22th January 1901

Europe: Italy, England and Crimea.  
Born on 12th May 1820  
Died on 13th August 1910.

What did they do to be significant?

Put an end to the slave trade

Made it so that children aged 5 to 10 had to go to school.

Founded modern nursing.

How and why?

He was a faithful Christian and felt slavery was not a 'Christain' thing to do.

Made it law so that children learning the skills and knowledge needed in later life.

Poor care for wounded soldiers and improved people's chances of survival hospital.

**Industrial revolution** - time of change that changed how people live.

**Social progress** - changes that were good in people's lives.

**Empire** - different people living under one ruler.

**Poverty** - not having the money for food, water or shelter.

**Workhouse** - a place where people without a home or job lived.

**Member of Parliament** - a person who represents the people.

**Slaves** - a person who belongs to someone else and is forced to do things for them.
