**Industrial revolution** - time of change that changed how people live. Social progress - changes that were good in people's lives. Empire - different people living under one ruler. Poverty - not having the money for food, water or shelter.

Workhouse - a place where people without a home or job lived.

Member of Parliament - a person who represents the people.
