Medical / Illness



<u>Medication -</u> If prescribed medicine is needed 4 times a day we can administer this once for you, we can not administer in school if it's only 3 times a day. We can only administer items that are prescribed by a doctor/dentist & have a pharmacy label. Parents/carers must fill in a medical consent form.

<u>Illness / Medical appointments / Late in to school -</u> If your child is going to be late into school due to a medical appointment, please ring the office to let us know. If you're leaving a voicemail please state what your child's lunch arrangements are. If your child is ill & absent from school, please call the school office on 01482 899485. The voicemail is the first option, the line opens at 8am. Please clearly state your child's full name, class and give as much detail as possible and be specific of ailments of why they're off ill eg-sickness bug/chicken pox/tonsillitis etc.

Family School Dinners

If you would like to come to school to have dinner with your child(ren) please ring the school office before 10am first to get booked in. Dinners are £4 each for adults and £2.60 for younger siblings (to be paid on Arbor)
