Formed by the Bath Folk Festival Director, Marrick Baxter, their music is a tapestry of tunes and songs from Celtic, British, Western and Eastern European traditions woven into a journey in which the audience are invited. John Doyle is one of the most influential and important musicians in Irish music today. He was a founding member of Irish American supergroup Solas in the 1990s and recently served as band leader for the Joan Baez band. As a guitarist, he is unparalleled for his harmonic and rhythmic genius. His instrumental prowess contributed to his 2010 GRAMMY nomination for Best Traditional World Music album for his collaboration with fiddler Liz Carroll on Double Play. In recent years Doyle has emerged as an important singer of Irish music as well; his 2010 collaboration, Exiles Return, with Karan Casey won him critical acclaim and solidified his reputation as a world class interpreter of traditional songs.

Singer / guitarist Kris Drever, from Orkney, is much-loved both in his own right and as a member of award winning trio Lau. His voice has a simple, but beguiling quality which transports the listener, backed by an accomplished, fluid guitar style. In his own words, "I like either to do songs that haven't been covered much before, or standards that are open to a different interpretation. I try to steer clear of that kind of typical folk-singer sound." As an evocation of one pivotal evening in the life of Bridie (Brenda Fricker), isolated, unmarried and at a rural Irish dance-hall, The Ballroom of Romance stands out for audiences in Ireland and Britain thirty years after its first broadcast. From his own short story (1972) Trevor's script is brought to the screen with artful brevity and lasting pathos by director Pat O'Connor. The assembled cast (Niall Tóibín, Brid Brennan, John Kavanagh and Cyril Cusak) is faultless, the sound-track captures the quiet desperation and, shot on location in Ballycroy, Co. Mayo, this authentic production rightly won two Jacob's TV awards and a BAFTA. The screening will feature an introductory lecture 'The Last Dance for Emigration? William Trevor's Screen Fictions' from Professor Lance Pettitt, Director of the Centre for Irish Studies, St Mary's University College, London.
