Medication in Schools

It has become necessary to change the way we administer medicine in school. Schools are now advised to minimise the administration of medication during the school day.

With immediate effect we will only administer medication to children if it has been prescribed by the GP. The medication must have your child's name and date of birth on the bottle/box with the dosage details.

Please be aware we will no longer be able to administer Calpol unless it has been prescribed by your GP and has your child's name on as stated above.

If your child is prescribed medication to be administered three times a day it is recommended that all three doses are administered at home; before school, after school and at bed time.

If at any time it is necessary for your child to receive medication in school please ensure you complete a consent form available from the school office. We cannot at any time give a child medication without the completion of this form by the parent.
