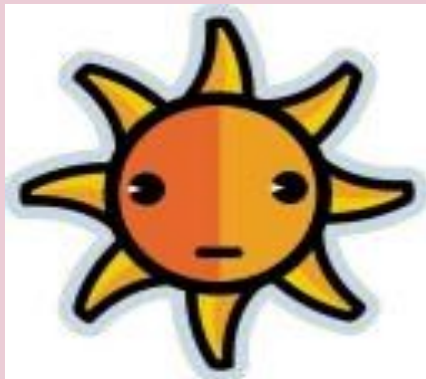

- ◆ **“Dream, Believe, Achieve”**

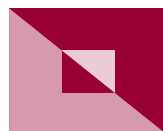
