

<b>2014 results</b>	<b>Hornsea Burton</b>
<b>EYFS</b>	<b>5 children (I joined after easter) 80% good level of development re standards</b>
<b>Y1 phonics</b>	<p>Y1-7 children in cohort-1 boy disapplied  <b>Out of these 7, 5 passed this year (71.4%)</b>  <b>This is a 28.6% points rise from last year and 64.3% points rise from 2012 when only 1 child passed.</b>  <b>2 children will need to retake the test Summer 2015.</b>  <u><b>YEAR 2 PHONICS TEST RETAKE</b></u>  5 children needed to retake the test 2014  <b>Out of these 5, 4 passed in this year (80%).</b>  <b>This is a 15.7% points rise since 2013.</b></p>
<b>KS1</b>	<p><b>9 pupils (6 boys, 3 girls) in the cohort (2 pupils joined us in Y2-one of these joining us in the Summer term!)</b>  <b>Reading APS 15.7</b>  88.9% of pupils achieving level 2 or better  66.7% of pupils achieving level 2B or better  22.2% of pupils achieving level 3 or above.  This is an improvement of 20.1% points rise from 2013 results.</p> <p><b>Writing APS 14.1</b>  88.9% of pupils achieving level 2 or better  55.6% of pupils achieving level 2B or better  0% of pupils achieving level 3 or above.  This is an improvement of 20.1% points rise from 2013 results.</p> <p><b>Maths APS 14.3</b>  88.9% of pupils achieving level 2 or better  66.7% of pupils achieving level 2B or better  0% of pupils achieving level 3 or above.  This is an improvement of 1.4% points rise from 2013 results.</p>
<b>KS2</b>	<p><b>14 pupils (6 boys and 8 girls) in cohort.</b>  <u><b>TEST DATA</b></u>  <u><b>Reading and Maths test and Writing APS 26.73</b></u>  50% of pupils achieving level 4 or better  43 % of pupils achieving level 4B or better  7% of pupils achieving level 5 or above.  This is an improvement from last year in both L4 and L5.</p> <p><b>Reading APS 28.3</b>  78.6% of pupils achieving level 4 or better  57.1% of pupils achieving level 4B or better  42.9% of pupils achieving level 5 or above.  This is an improvement from last year, especially at L5.</p>

**93% of pupils achieved 2+ levels of progress in Reading**  
(improvement from 2013 when it was 71%)  
**43% of pupils achieved 3 levels of progress in Reading**  
(improvement from 2013 when it was 14.3%).  
**7% of pupils achieved 4 levels of progress in reading!**

**Writing (TA) APS 27.0**

85.7% of pupils achieving level 4 or better  
71.4% of pupils achieving level 4B or better  
14.3% of pupils achieving level 5 or above.  
This is much better than last year at L4.

**93% of pupils achieved 2+ levels of progress in Writing (TA)**  
**14% of pupils achieved 3 levels of progress in Writing.**

**Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar APS 25.7**

64% of pupils achieving level 4 or better  
43% of pupils achieving level 4B or better  
29% of pupils achieving level 5 or above.

**Maths APS 24.9**

57% of pupils achieving level 4 or better  
43% of pupils achieving level 4B or better  
7% of pupils achieving level 5 or above.  
This is much better than last year for L4+

**Maths was the area that let us down in the tests once again  
this year and some children not doing as well as expected  
compared to their performance throughout the year in their  
work and teacher assessment.**

**71% of pupils achieved 2+ levels of progress in Maths**  
**7% of pupils achieved 3 levels of progress in Maths.**
