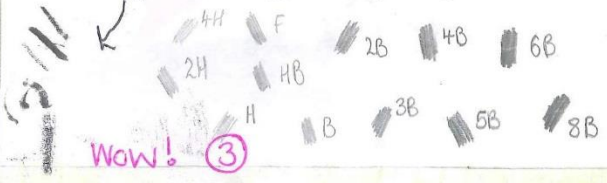

You can use different tools as well such as graphite and different types of pencils.



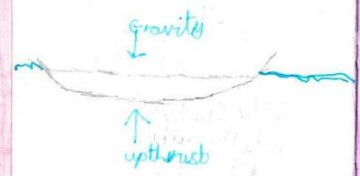

The grusum Grendel and heroic Bar-wulf battled it out with no escapes for Grendel, he was left for dead bleeding to death.

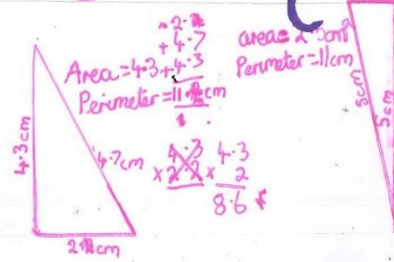
Reading/Tasks

Synopsis of Beowulf



Since my boat floated because the upthrust was less than the force of gravity. For something to float the upthrust and gravity must be equal. It's impossible for the upthrust to be more powerful than gravity because upthrust sets up pull when something lifts out of the water.



In the diagrams it shows that for a boat to float, the materials must be light-weight and waterproof, and that the upthrust must be equal to the force from gravity. The force from gravity is always the same, it is the force from upthrust that changes.

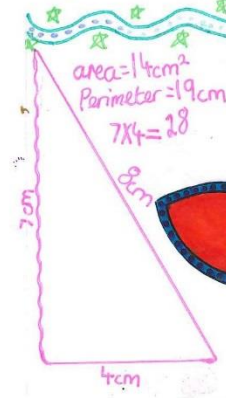
When they finally get to the car, Percy collapses.
