



## Primary School Sport Funding

### Lyneham Primary School

The government is providing sports funding for schools for THREE years (2013/14, 2014/15 & 2015/16) and this has now been extended to 2020. The money is to be allocated to schools to improve the quality of Physical Education for children.

We were allocated: 5,542.00 Oct 2013 and will be funded £3028 in April 2014.

At Lyneham Primary School we are focusing our Physical Education in the following ways;

- ❖ Teachers released to observe, team teach with Swindon Town Football I C
- ❖ Fund new teacher professional development opportunities
- ❖ Ensuring all children are included
- ❖ Increasing participation rates in sporting events, e.g. in cluster festivals
- ❖ Continue to enter sporting competitions, e.g. 'The Bigdance off', a national dance competition
- ❖ Purchasing quality assured professional development resources
- ❖ Sports Coaches in school
- ❖ Run swimming sessions for all KS2 children
- ❖ Annual sports week
- ❖ Strengthening local community links
- ❖ Run master classes for gifted and talented children; e.g. dance
