

Governors' Policy Statement of Equal Opportunities



Kirkdale, St. Lawrence Church of England Primary School is committed to providing an environment which is conducive to learning and where all children can develop skills and attitudes for life. Each child is valued and respected regardless of ability, race, gender, religion, social background, culture or disability and is offered a child-centred curriculum, opportunities to develop to their full potential, the means to develop physically, intellectually, emotionally and socially and the chance to develop good behaviour and responsible attitudes for life.

Staff will ensure their approach to all children is non-discriminatory, that all groups have equal access to the full range of educational opportunities provided by the school and that diversity is celebrated.
