Listen, respond to and write poems on a transport theme

Identify rhyming words and create own rhymes about travelling

Identify features of non-fiction texts, use alphabetical order, glossaries and indexes, create non-fiction page about a method of transport

Read and respond to stories with fantasy settings, create and describe own fantasy settings.

Science

Investigate which materials would be best to create a safety badge to show up in the dark when riding a bike

Explore simple forces, make predictions, test and record results for an investigation involving toy cars

History:

Identify ways vehicles have changed over time

Put vehicles in chronological order

Use written information and photographs to find out about transport in the past

Numeracy: (Topic)

Collect data and create simple graphs with a transport theme

Describe position, direction and movements including half, quarter and three quarter

Geography:

Through the theme of Barnaby Bear's travels name and locate the countries of the UK and their capital cities, use and create simple maps and plans, understand simple geographical symbols and compare and describe a variety of locations

RE/PSHE

Listen to, retell and act out stories from the Old Testament to explore the theme "Can stories change people?"

Explore theme of personal safety in a variety of contexts

Art/DT

Make observational drawings of bicycles

Create hot air balloon art using mixed media

Use paper sculpture to make 3D art work of water transport
