We aim to develop the whole child so that they leave our school as confident, independent learners and creative, critical thinkers.

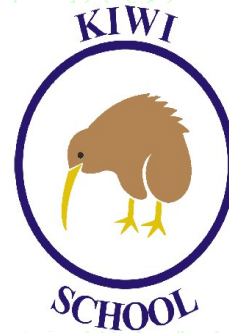
We encourage high quality work through high expectations and try to instil a positive work ethic and a respect for honesty which will prepare our children for adult life.

We aim to create a learning community, where everyone works together to realise this Mission Statement. We will do what we say we do.

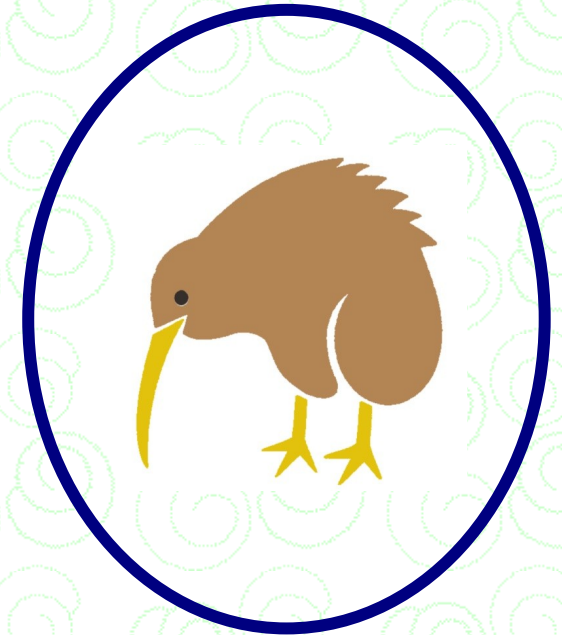
