

## **What support will there be for my child's/young person's overall well-being?**

Mrs. Butler (Pupil & Family Support Manager) and Miss. Griffiths (Pupil & Family Support Worker) both work with pupils and families supporting individual family needs. This may be on an individual basis or in a targeted small group intervention.

Relevant staff are trained to support medical needs and many staff have up to date first aid training. We have a **medical policy in place** and staff are trained for administering any specific medicines when the need arises.

Our Behaviour Policy; which includes guidance on expectations, rewards and sanctions is fully understood and in place by all staff. Our staff reinforces the behaviour policy consistently throughout all aspects of the school. There have been no exclusions.

The school has a school council and listens carefully to the pupil voice to help make improvements to the school. The school council work closely with the head teacher and any concerns are followed up.

We regularly monitor attendance and take the necessary actions to prevent prolonged unauthorised absence. Attendance rates at our school are rising and the Pupil & Family Support Manager and Headteacher monitor attendance weekly. Support is available if families are experiencing difficulties with attendance.

Allocated teaching assistants may provide additional support for some children during break and lunch times. We have playground buddies to support some children or supported to play in a smaller area of the playground.

The catering team can cater for a wide range of specialist dietary requirement meals e.g. dairy free.
